

NE NW; Exposure along east-facing, curved bare bank directly west of US 36 and K 27 intersection.

- Sand light brown, limy, contains chunks of clay, volcanic ash, and gravel. Shows definite Ogallala characteristics.

 Thickness varies, but about 6 ft. exposed.
- Clay shale medium brown, dry surface cracks in the "crackle" pattern characteristic of bentonite but the shale does not appear bentonitic. Estimated thickness about 15 ft. Grab sample taken (757-29340).
- Unit described above grades into or is the upper part of the unit below.
- Clay shale resembles unit above except predominantly dark gray with a little brown; does not show the bentonite "crackle" pattern as well as the unit above.
