

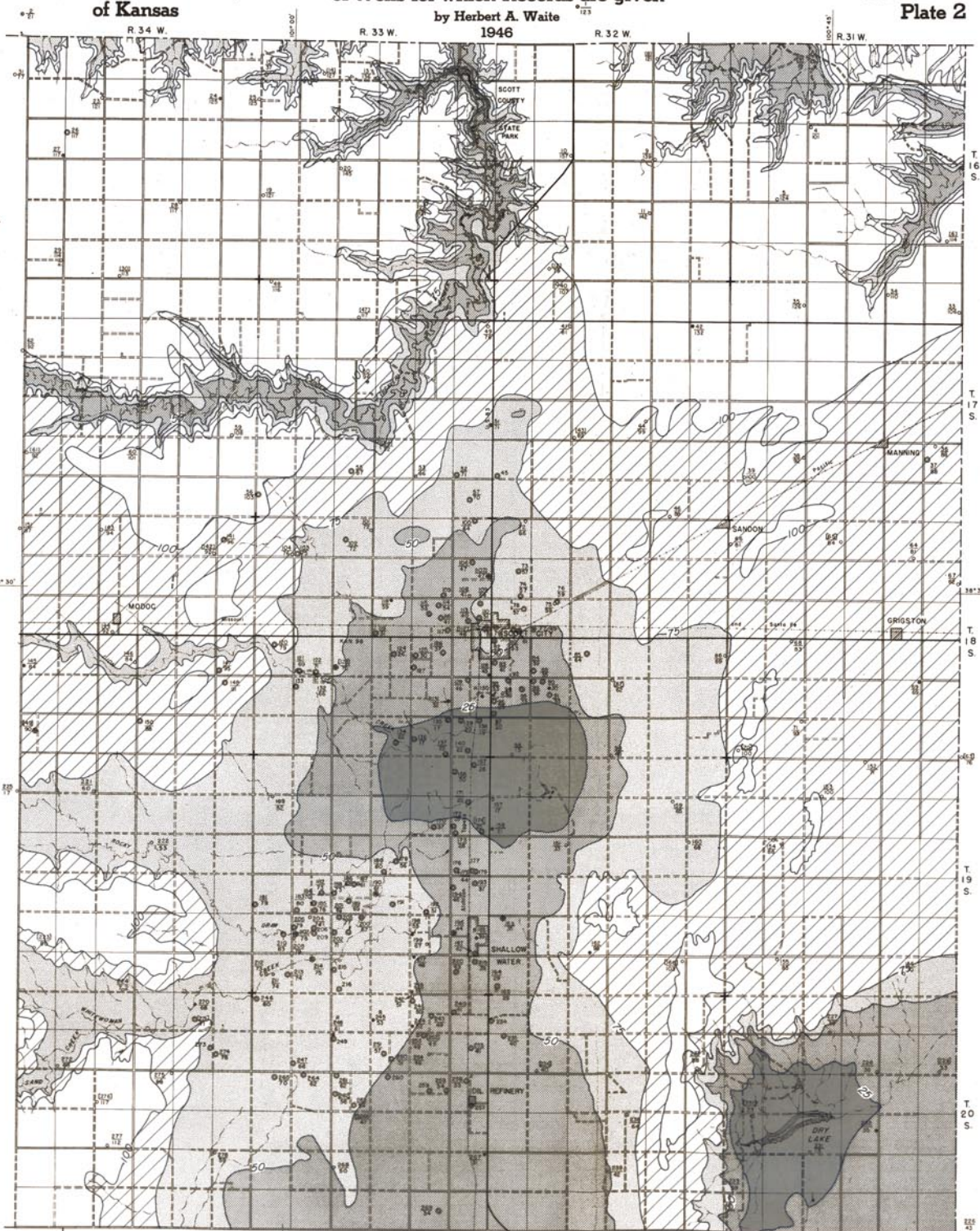
# MAP OF SCOTT COUNTY
