

Wichita Well Sample Library Preservation Activities in 2009

✓ Oil and gas operators provided the Wichita Well Sample Library formation samples from 1,355 wells.

✓ A total of 2,014 staff hours were needed to process and preserve samples from 1,326 wells.

✓ Samples were processed at a rate of 715 sample feet per hour.

✓ 111,250 sample envelopes and 1,051 library boxes were used in the preservation process.

✓ Samples from 58 wells were not geologically significant to the operator and the Library and were discarded.

✓ A total of 1.44 million sample feet were preserved, equivalent to the straight-line distance between Wichita and Kansas City.

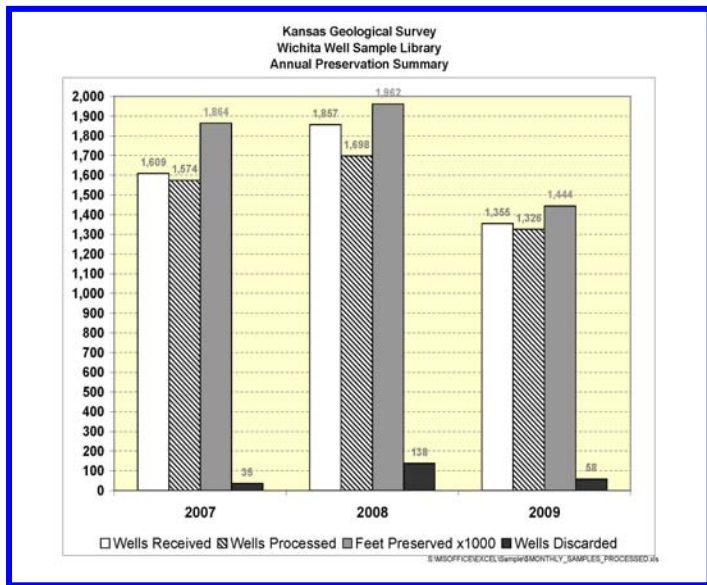


Figure 3.--Map showing distribution of oil or gas well samples preserved in 2009 by total sample depth
