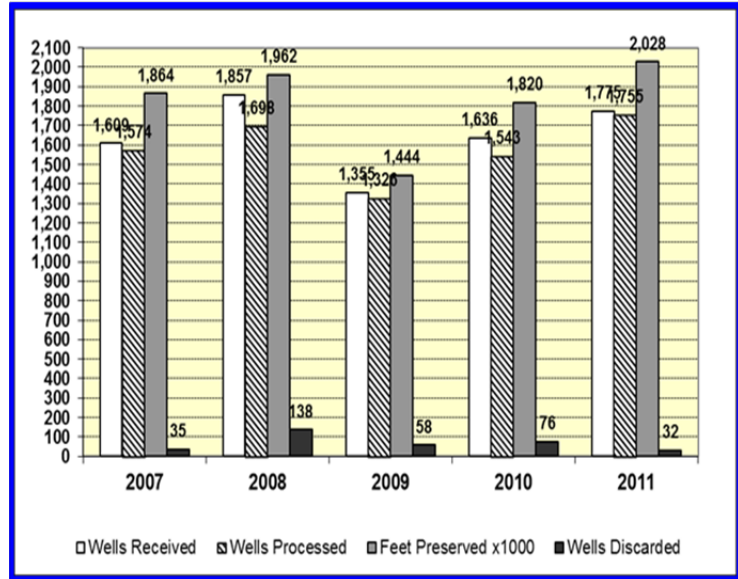


## Wichita Well Sample Library 2011 Preservation Activities

- ✓ Oil and gas operators provided the Wichita Well Sample Library formation samples from 1,775 wells.
- ✓ Samples from 1,755 wells were preserved at an average rate of 1,164 sample feet per hour for a total of 1,815 processing hours.
- ✓ 180,000 sample envelopes and 1,635 sample boxes were used in the preservation process.
- ✓ Samples from 32 wells were discarded because the samples were not geologically significant to the oil or gas operator and the Library.
- ✓ Staff preserved 2.03 million sample feet, equivalent to the distance from earth to the Hubble Space Telescope in orbit.
- ✓ The sample maintenance program examined 690 sample boxes and resolved 3,659 issues including recovering missing samples for 140 wells.
