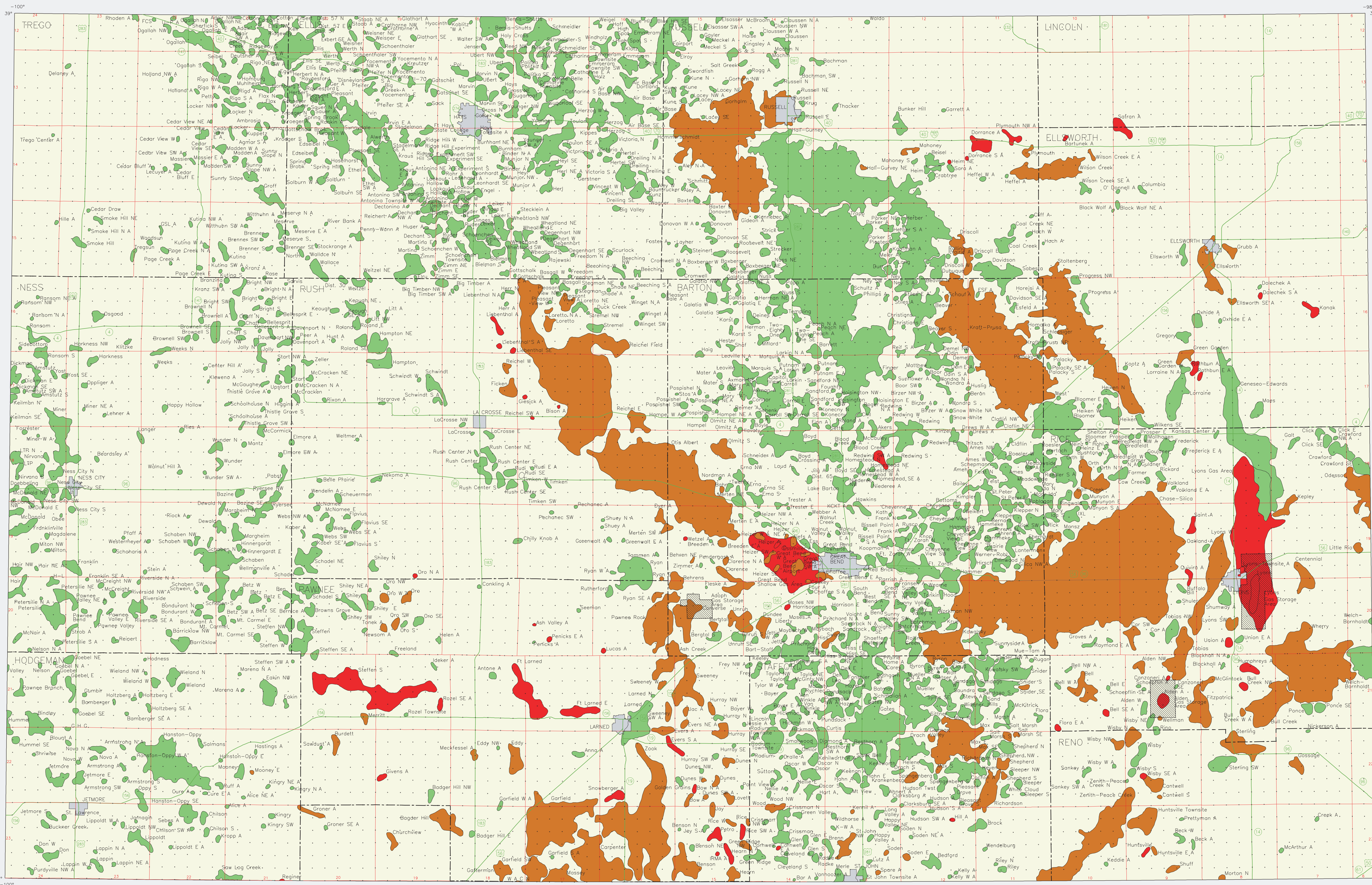

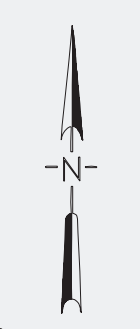
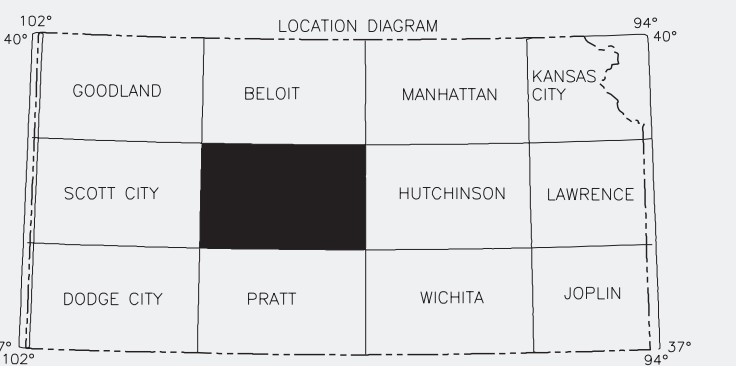
OIL AND GAS FIELDS GREAT BEND QUADRANGLE IN KANSAS 1993
