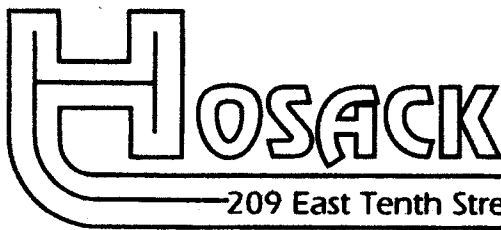

The City of St. Paul, Kansas, located in Neosho County, was recently awarded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to construct improvements to the City's streets. As a part of the CDBG environmental review process, comments on this proposed project by your agency are hereby requested. In order for your agency's comments to be considered, they must be received in writing at the **letterhead address** above on or before **Friday, February 21, 2003**. If your agency does not respond by the specified date, it will be considered as a "no comment" on the project.

The proposed project will consist of improvements to 15 blocks of existing streets, consisting of approximately 360 cubic yards of asphalt milling and removal; removal of 866 linear feet of existing curb and gutter; installation of 866 linear feet of new curb and gutter, and 4 sidewalk ramps; 4,087 tons of asphalt overlay; and 20 square yards of alley entrances, removal and replacement. A project location map is enclosed for your review.

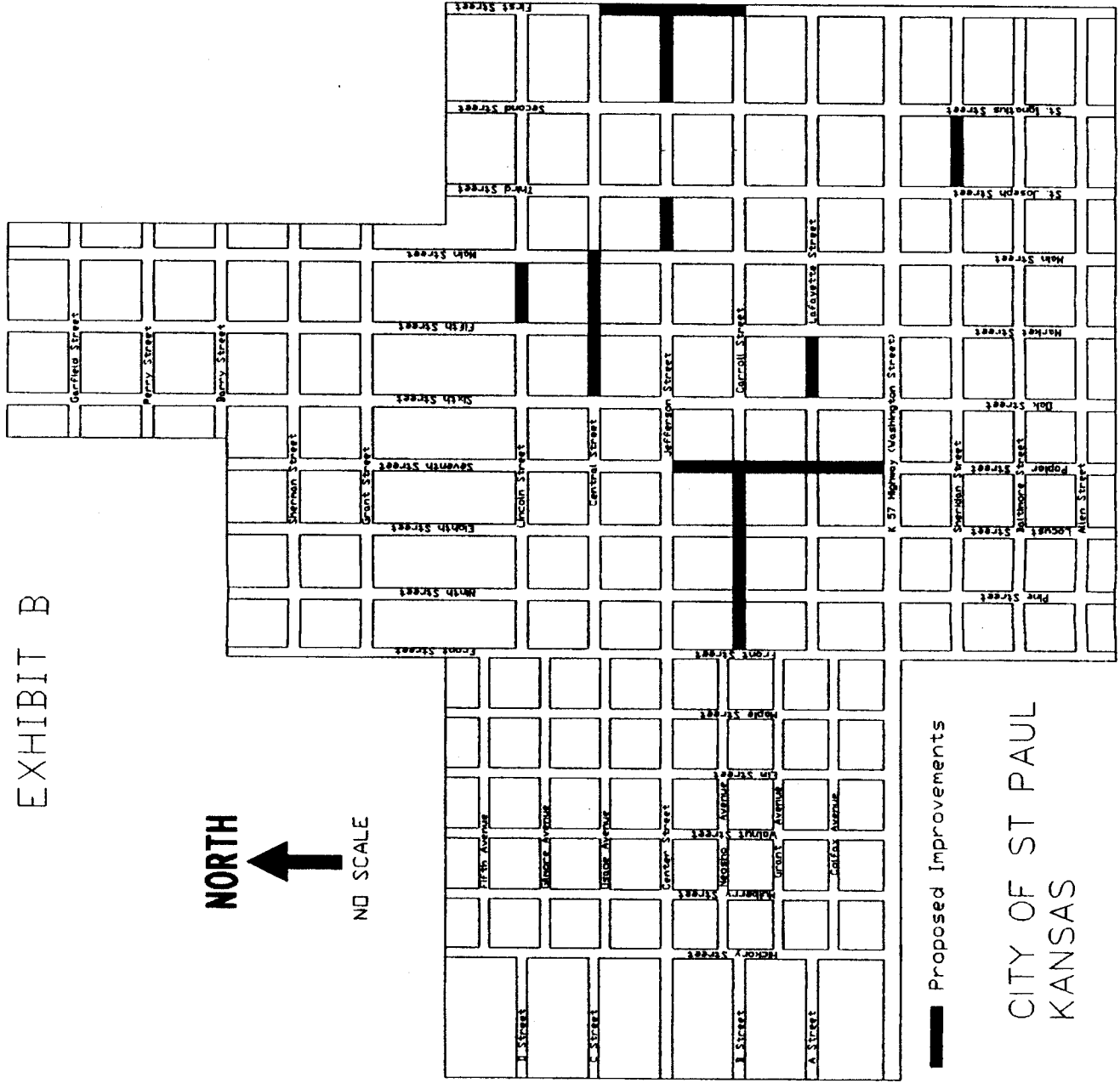
