Comments: Any short-term adverse impacts during construction should be offset by the long-term benefits to the water supply system. Note that some limestone bedrock in Marion County has fractures that have been enlarged by ground water dissolution. Thus, make sure that the footing for the tower is installed after determining that the bedrock does not have cavities that could cause problems at the site.

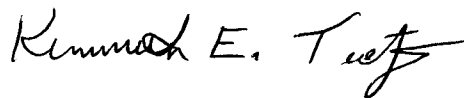

Marion County Rural Water District No. 1 is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for Project No. 2332. RWD #1 serves 330 households in Northwest Marion County and Southern Dickinson County in Central Kansas.

The project involves building a 200,000 gallon elevated storage tank to replace a 30-year-old, 54,000-gallon standpipe, which is no longer large enough to serve the needs of the community. Effective storage capacity will be increased from a few hours to over a day. The new tower would be constructed adjacent to the existing standpipe four and one-half miles West of Tampa, KS in the SE ¼ of 29-17-2 in Marion County.

We would appreciate your review of the project description and location, and any comments you may have, within 30 days. Maps of the location and a project review form are enclosed for your use.
