Rural Water District #1, Woodson County is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the referenced project.

We would appreciate your review of the project description and location, and any comments that you may have, within 30 days. A project review form is enclosed for your use.

Rural Water District #1's water plant will not be able to comply with new governmental regulations affecting water suppliers. It appears to be more feasible to purchase water from other water sources for our district rather than spend a great amount of money on water plant rehabilitation.

Installing six miles of 10 inch water line between the City of Iola and Rural Water District #1's water tower at Piqua would allow us to supply water to our service area in Woodson, Allen and Wilson Counties. A site map is enclosed to show the proposed water line path.

Iola is in the process of building a new water plant and their water production will be more than enough to supply our daily needs of approximately 120 to 160 thousand gallons per day.

We presently produce water from our water plant in Neosho Falls, Ks for the majority of our district. We also purchase water from the City of Yates Center, Ks for a small part of our district. Rural Water District #1 has an estimated 600 miles of water line.

The loan amount from the Kansas Department of Health and environment is \$500,000. It is our goal to stay under that amount for this project.
