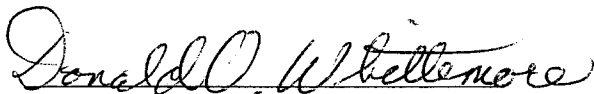

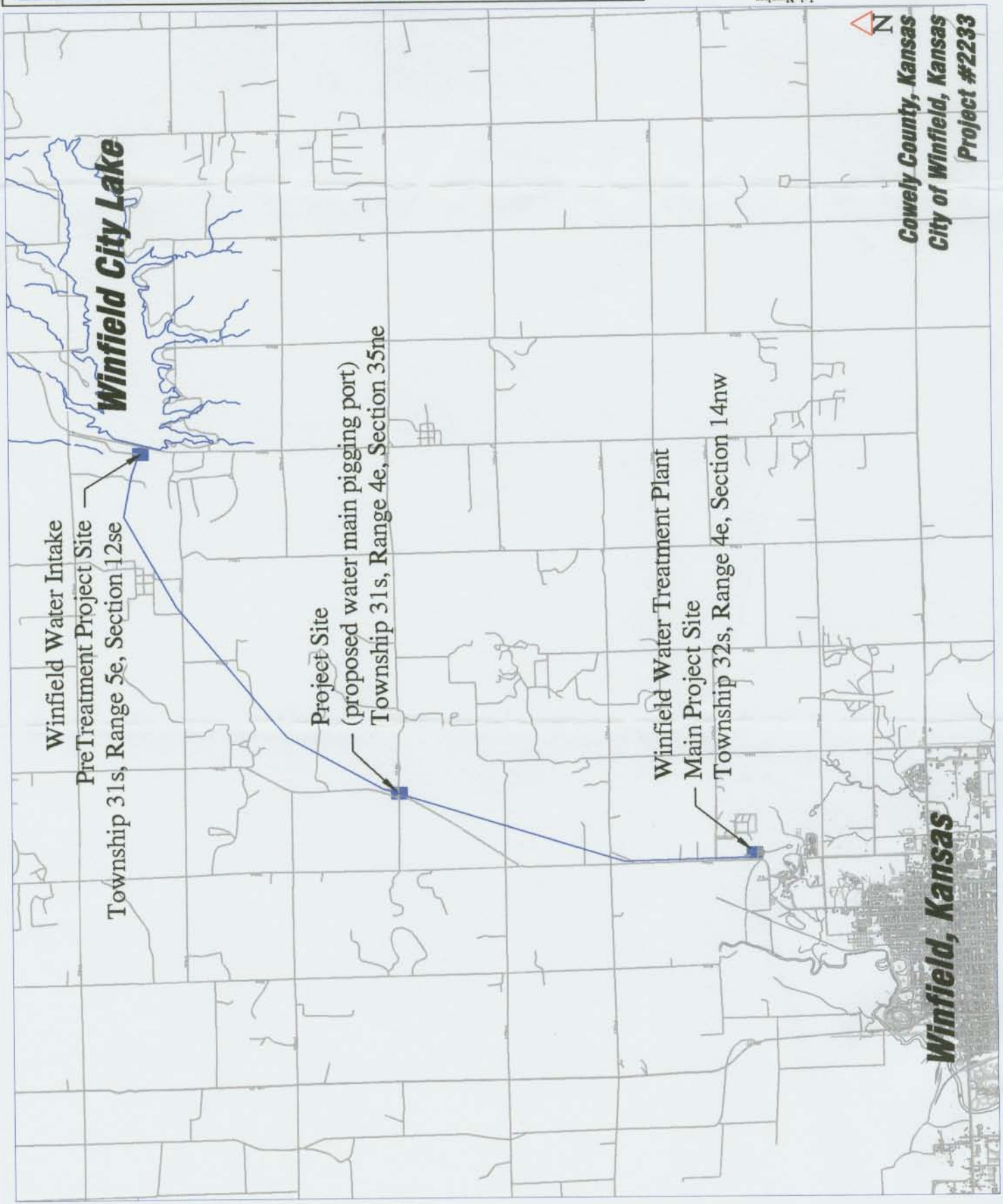
The City of Winfield is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the reference project.
