I have received your request for comment by the Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) on an application to USDA Rural Development from Mike Floersch, dba, CCP, Inc to assist in the purchase and replacement of 10 HVAC units in the strip mall "Clay Center Plaza". The business is located at 722 W. Crawford, Clay Center, Clay County, Kansas 67432.

I examined the Clay Center NW 7½-minute topographic map, a 2002 orthophotograph, and a KGS report on the geology and ground-water resources of Clay County (Walters and Bayne, 1959, KGS Bulletin 136). The geologic map indicates that the site is on Wisconsinan Terrace Deposits. These deposits are mostly alluvium deposited along the Republican River during the Ice Ages. Northwest of Clay Center, this unit can provide large quantities of ground water and should be considered an aquifer. The business site is not located along a stream or river. The Kansas Geological Survey has no knowledge of geologic issues affecting this application. I have signed and enclosed the Agency Review Transmittal Form.
