Dear Mr. Schminke:

I have received your request for comment by the Kansas Geological Survey on a Rural Business Enterprise Grant through USDA-Rural Development to assist Malone, Inc./dba/ All About Quilts, Manhattan, Kansas. The proposed loan will be used to purchase real estate and building improvements for a new quilting business located at 8651 U.S. Rte. 24, Manhattan, Pottawatomie County, Kansas.

I reviewed the limited information you provided along with data from the Manhattan 7½ minute quadrangle, a 2002 orthophotograph, and the geologic report of Pottawatomie County (Scott, Foster, and Crumpton, 1959, U.S. Geological Survey Bulletin 1060-C). The site does not appear to be in a drainage way and the geologic unit is an alluvial terrace. Alluvial terrace materials are similar to river alluvium but at higher elevations. This material should be considered an aquifer, and care should be taken in handling any hazardous materials at this site. The Kansas Geological Survey has no knowledge of other geologic factors that would adversely affect this project.
