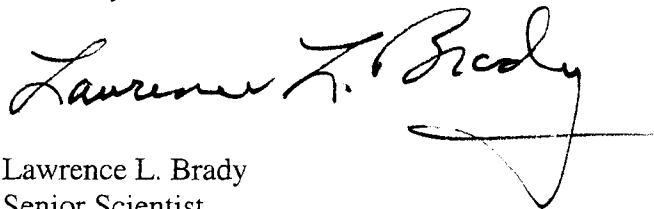

I received your inquiry to the Kansas Geological Survey seeking input on "Environmental Assessment Comments" for improvements to the sewer system for the City of Caney, Kansas. The project consists of reconstruction or rehabilitation of approximately 4,600 linear feet of 15-inch diameter sanitary sewer line. This line is used to convey wastewater from the south half of Caney to the city wastewater treatment plant.
