I received your inquiry to the Kansas Geological Survey seeking input on "Environmental Assessment Comments" for improvements to the sewer system for the City of Humboldt, Kansas. The project consists of a number of upgrades to the sewer system, including TV inspection of 10,000 feet of existing sewer lines, rehabilitation of ten manholes, and new or upgrades of existing sewer lines (approximately 14,300 ft).

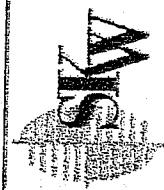
