To whom it may concern:

The Topeka Department of Public Works is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the referenced project. One of the requirements of KDHE is that applicants request comments/clearance from a number of government agencies. Your agency is one of those listed. We would appreciate your review of the project description and location, and any comments you may have, within 30 days of your receipt of this letter.

Funding would be used to install new water mains and appurtenances on the streets approaching the Topeka Boulevard Bridge due to bridge replacement. The streets are listed as follows: (1) Tyler Street – Crane Street to 2nd Street; (2) Topeka Blvd – 2nd Street to 4th Street; (3) Harrison Street – Crane Street to 2nd Street; (4) Crane Street – Tyler Street to Harrison Street; (5) 1st Street – Harrison Street to Van Buren Street; (6) 2nd Street – Tyler Street to Harrison Street. North of the Kansas River: (1) North Tyler Street – Curtis Street to Laurent Street; and (2) Curtis Street – North Tyler Street to North Topeka Blvd. The project is part of the 2002 Distribution System Analysis and Report. The project locations are as follows: (1) Section 30, Township 11 South, Range 16 East; and (2) Section 31, Township 11 South, Range 16 East. Attached is a site map, proposed project budget, and a form to be used for your review comments.

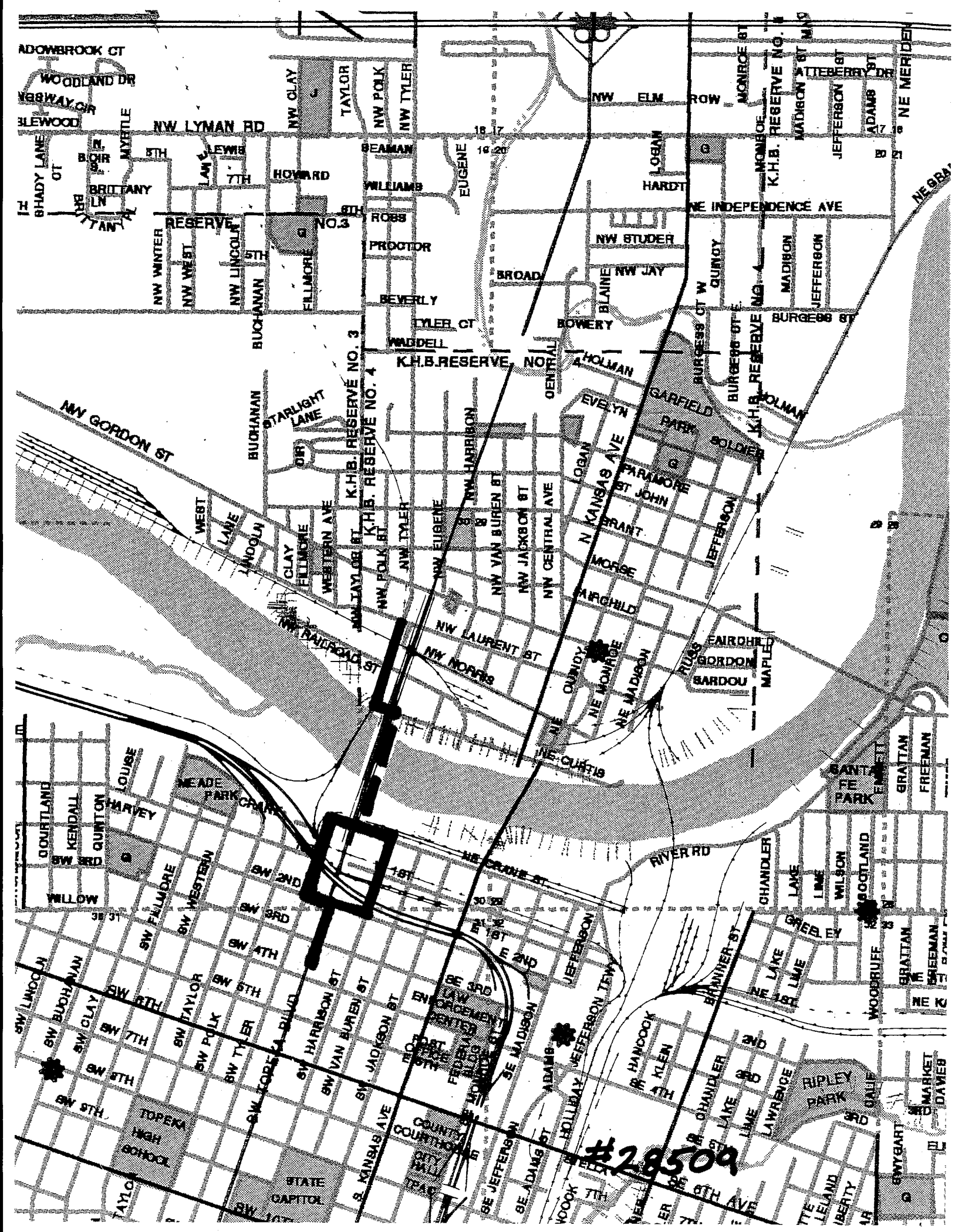
