The City of Edgerton is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the referenced project. The following is a description of the proposed project.

Project Description: Replacement and relocation of approximately 700 feet of existing transite pipe (currently located on McDonald Street and crossing the BNSF railroad) with 8-inch PVC pipe (to be relocated to Nelson Street and run from the west side of the railroad tracks to the east side of the tracks to the existing service line to the wastewater treatment plant).

Location: Section 7, Township 15S, Range 22E (see enclosed USGS Map)

Purpose: Replace and relocate existing transite pipe.

Estimated Cost: Construction cost is estimated to be \$63,000.

Environmental: Route is through previously disturbed area; project does not cross or interfere with any creeks or streams or farmland.
