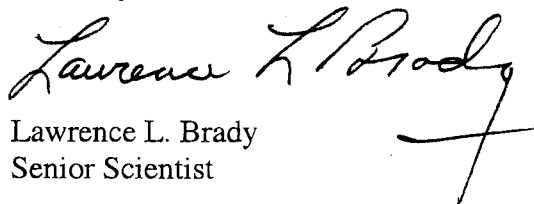
Dear Mr. Erbe:

I received your inquiry to the Kansas Geological Survey seeking input on "Environmental Assessment Comments" for improvements to the street curbs and sidewalks in the central business district for the City of Fredonia, Kansas. The project consists of a number of upgrades to the sidewalks, curbing, and the placing of ADA ramps as shown on the map and diagrams attached with your letter.

It is my understanding that this review is necessary for the City of Fredonia to be considered for a grant for these sidewalk, curbing, and ADA ramp improvements from the Kansas Department of Commerce Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program. I do not recognize any specific problems with your request based on the information you have provided. Therefore, the Kansas Geological Survey provides the necessary clearance from our agency for your project and I have signed the form requesting environment assessment comments.

The above discussion represents our best assessment based on the information that the Kansas Geological Survey has about this locality and/or proposed project at the time of this writing. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the Kansas Geological Survey has no knowledge, may affect the viability or safe operation of this facility or property. The information provided in this letter is from regional or countywide studies and should not be used as a substitute for detailed site characterization by a licensed geologist or engineer. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any required site characterizations.
