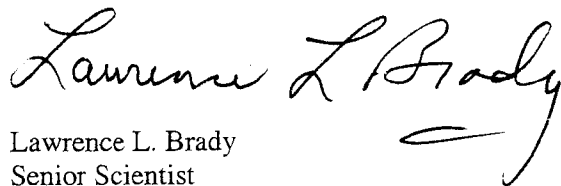
Dear Ms. Galemore:

I received your inquiry to the Kansas Geological Survey seeking input on "Environmental Assessment Comments" by The City of Neodesha, Kansas, for utility extension from existing utility tie points in Neodesha to the new Wilson County hospital.

It is my understanding that this review is necessary for this project to be considered for a grant to assist with this utility extension. Although not mentioned in the information sent to the Kansas Geological Survey, I assume that the application is to the Kansas Department of Commerce for their Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program. I do not recognize any potential geological or environmental problems with this proposal if careful engineering is utilized, especially with borings under the Fall River as shown on the engineering drawings. Therefore, the Kansas Geological Survey provides the necessary clearance from our agency for your project and I have signed the form requesting environmental assessment comments.

The above discussion represents our best assessment based on the information that the Kansas Geological Survey has about this locality and/or proposed project at the time of this writing. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the Kansas Geological Survey has no knowledge, may affect the viability or safe operation of this facility or property. The information provided in this letter is from regional or countywide studies and should not be used as a substitute for detailed site characterization by a licensed geologist or engineer. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any required site characterizations.

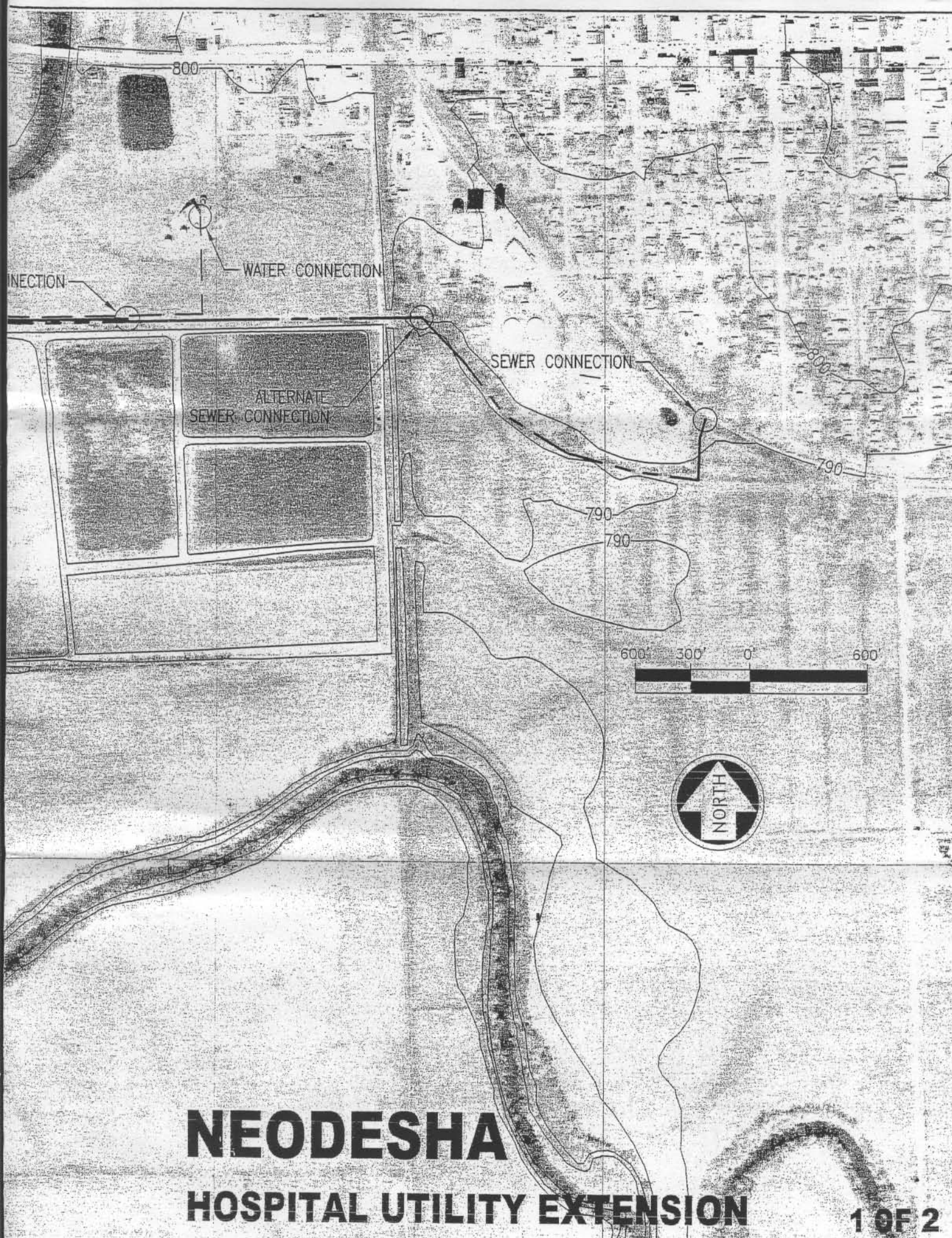

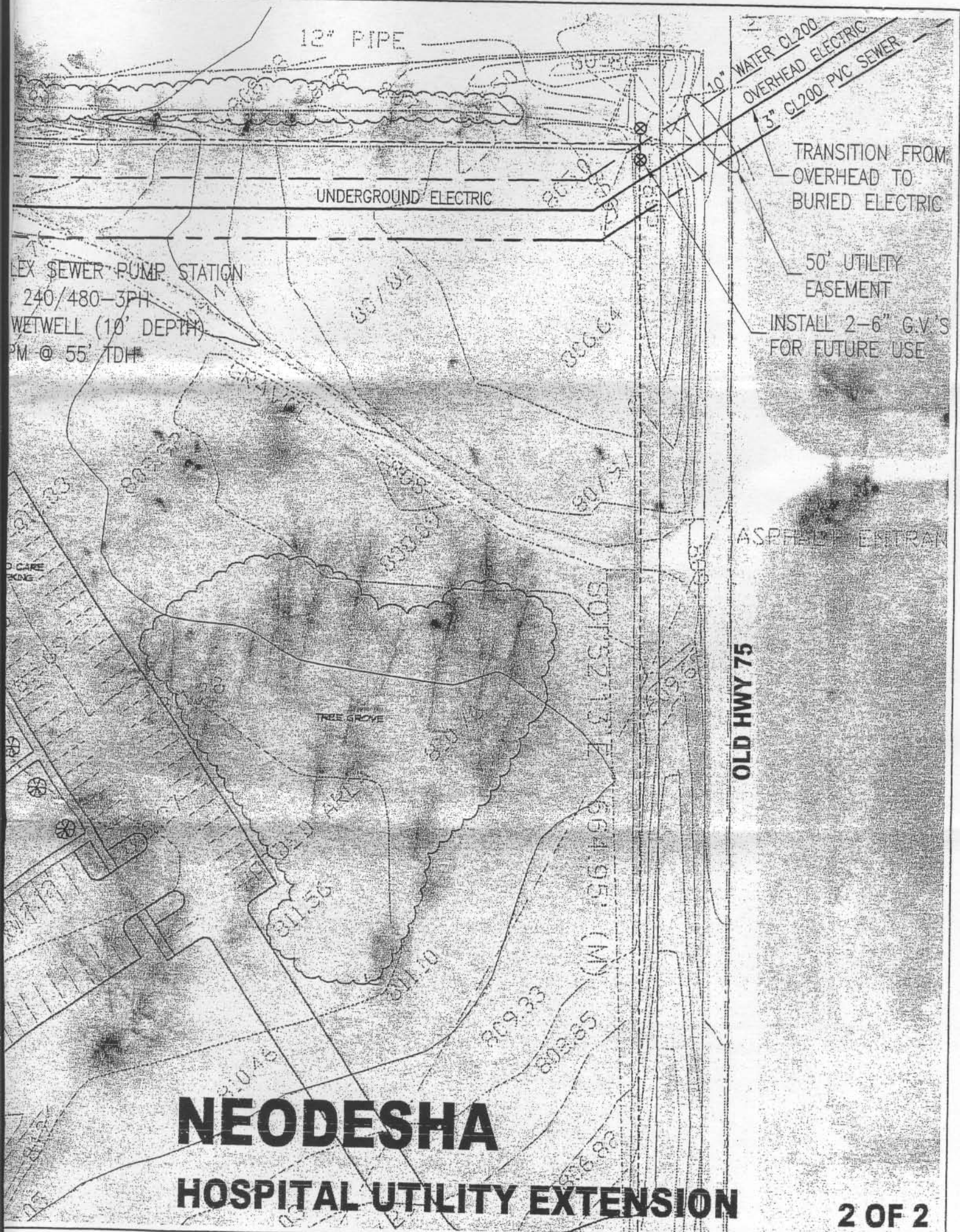
