I received your inquiry to the Kansas Geological Survey seeking input on "Environmental Assessment Comments" for the construction of a new city building for the City of Mound City, located in Linn County, Kansas. The project involves the construction of a 6,700 square foot steel frame building to house the city hall, public library, community room, and also to serve as a public storm shelter.

It is my understanding that this review is necessary for this project to be considered for a Kansas Department of Commerce Small Cities Community Development Block Grant to assist with the cost of construction of the new city building. Based on the information provided to the Kansas Geological Survey, I do not recognize any potential problems with this proposal. Therefore, the Kansas Geological Survey provides the necessary clearance from our agency for your project and I have signed the form requesting environmental assessment comments.

The above discussion represents our best assessment based on the information that the Kansas Geological Survey has about this locality and/or proposed project at the time of this writing. 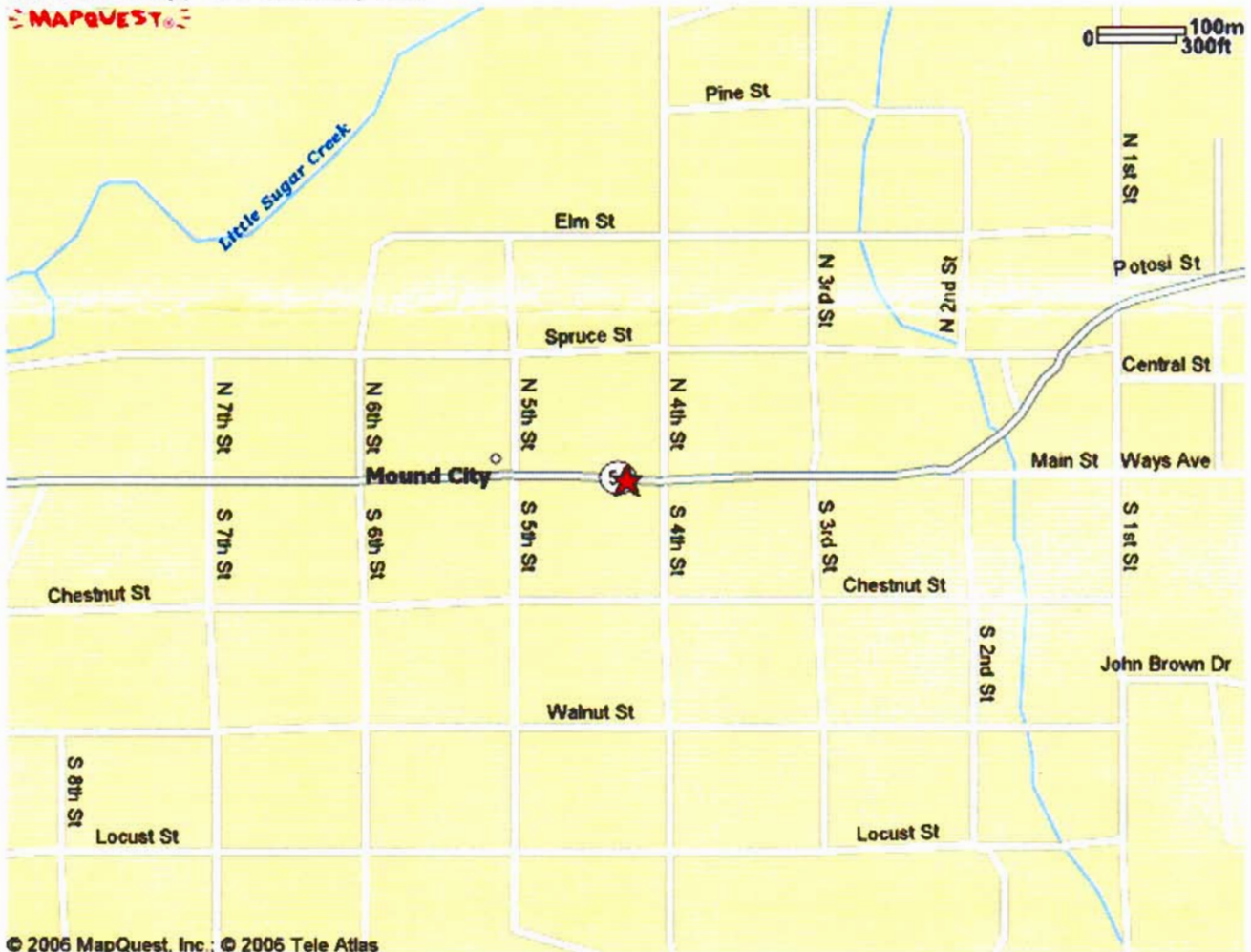
