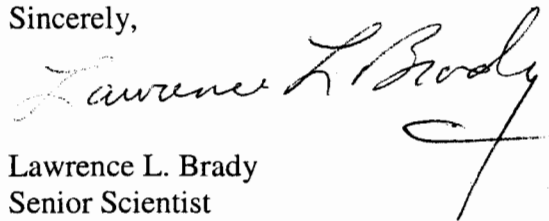
Dear Ms. Galemore:

I received your inquiry to the Kansas Geological Survey seeking input on "Environmental Assessment Comments" for renovations to the Bourbon County jail located at 210 S. National, Fort Scott, Kansas. The project involves the renovation of existing jail facilities to incorporate additional detention space.

It is my understanding that this review is necessary for this project to be considered for a Kansas Department of Commerce Small Cities Community Development Block Grant to assist with the cost of renovation of the existing county jail building. Based on the information provided to the Kansas Geological Survey, I do not recognize any potential geological or environmental problems with this proposal. 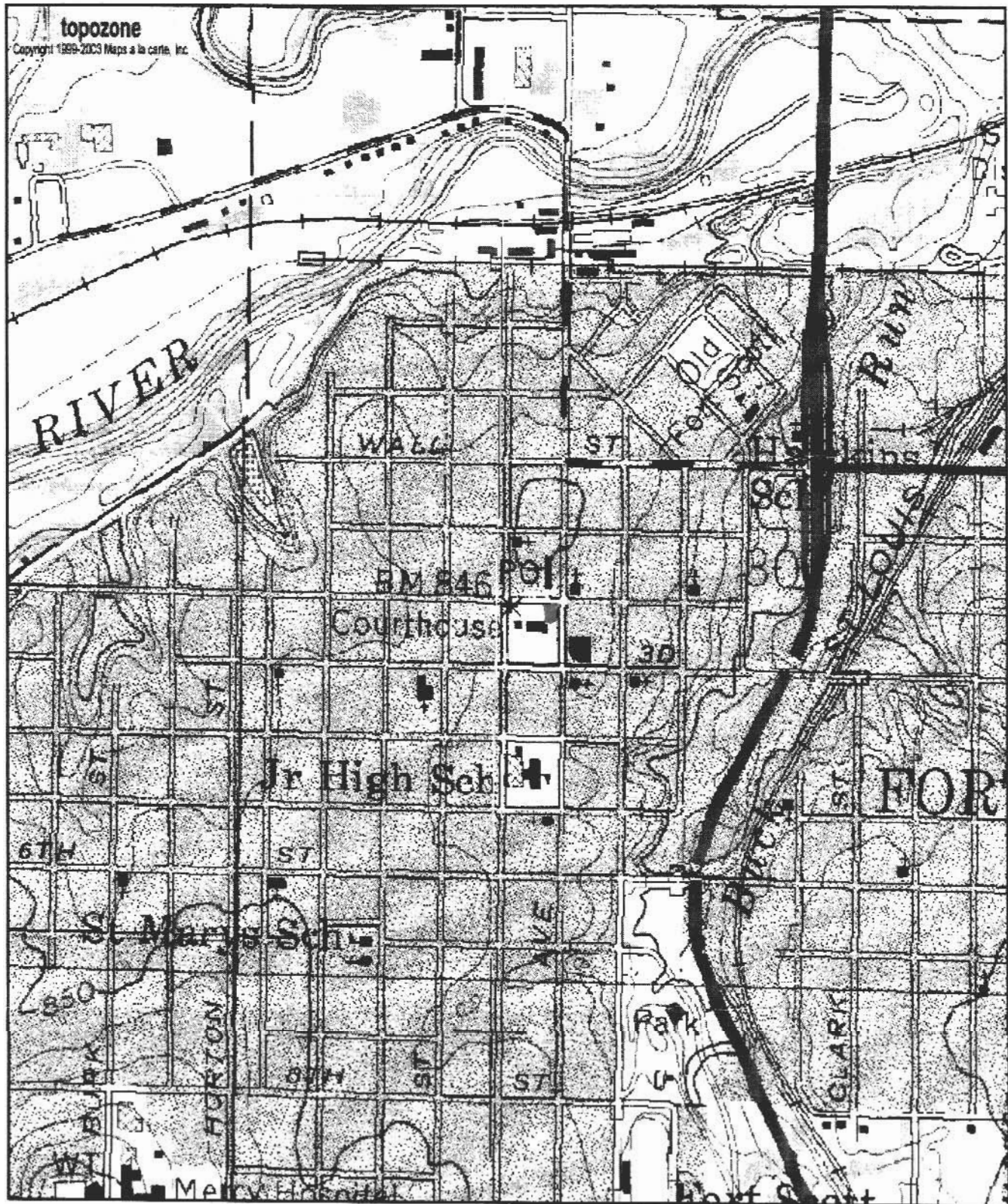

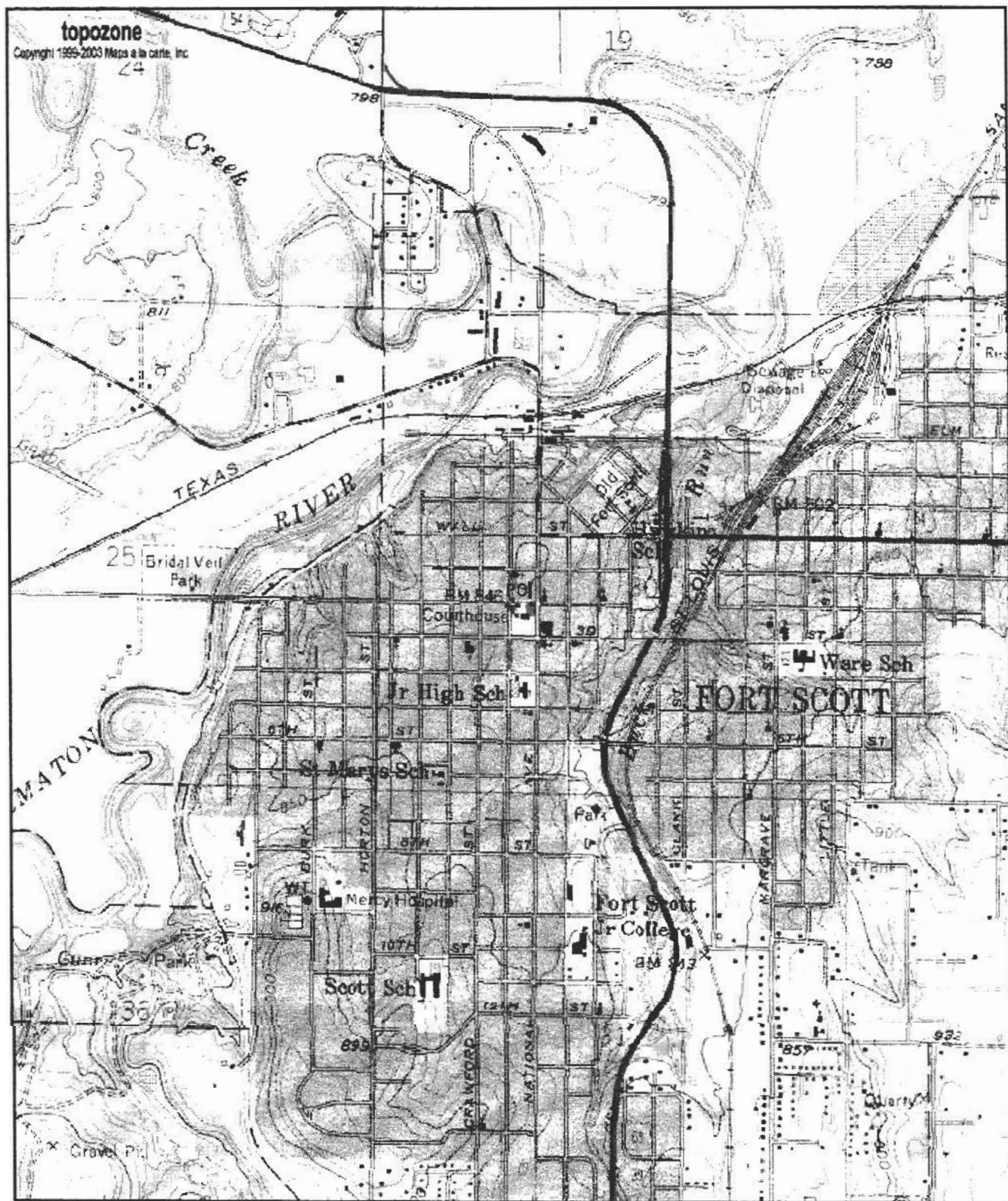
