The City of Erie, Kansas, located in Neosho County, is applying for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the demolition and clearance of a building located at 111 South Main Street in Erie. As a part of the CDBG environmental review process, comments on this proposed project by your agency are hereby requested. In order for your agency's comments to be considered, they must be received in writing at the **letterhead address** above on or before **Wednesday, October 18, 2006**. If your agency does not respond by the specified date, it will be considered as a "no comment" on the project.

The entire roof and second floor of the building located at 111 South Main Street in Erie has collapsed, leaving only its exterior walls and debris. A licensed professional engineer has determined that the walls are structurally unsound and the debris has created a public safety and health hazard. An accredited asbestos inspector conducted a survey of the building and its debris for asbestos containing materials (ACM) and no ACM was found in the samples taken. The CDBG project is to consist of the demolition of the building's remaining walls and the removal and disposal of all debris in accordance with applicable Federal, state and local laws. Enclosed for your review are two recent photographs of the building. One of the photographs is of the building's exterior and the other is of the interior. Also enclosed is a project location map.

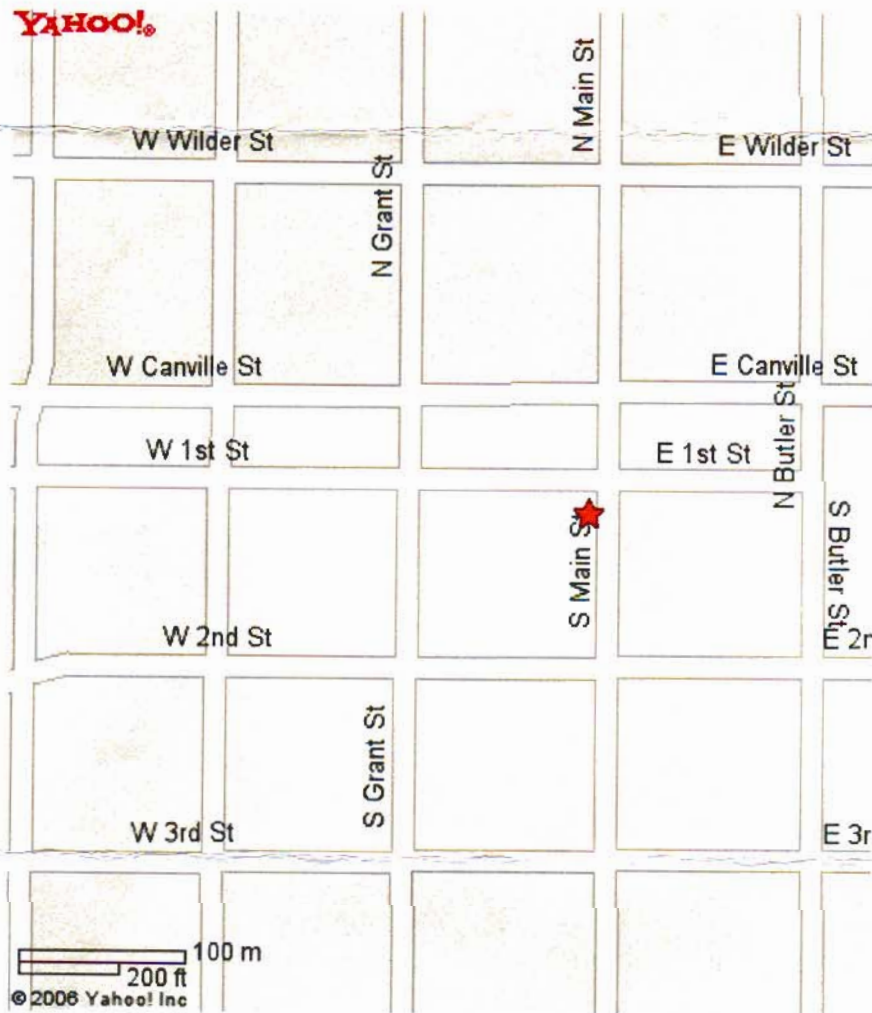
