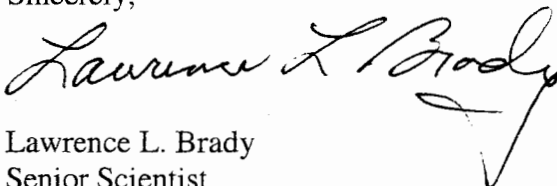
Dear Ms. Voorhies:

I have reviewed the information you submitted with your inquiry to the Kansas Geological Survey seeking input on "Environmental Assessment Comments" for construction of a metal building to the existing fire department building within the City of St. Paul, Kansas. The review is for a grant request from the City of St. Paul through the Southeast Kansas Regional Planning Commission to the Kansas Department of Commerce, Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program for the construction of the building. The new building is planned as a 50' x 55' metal building at 427 Main as an addition to the fire department.

I do not anticipate environmental problems associated with the construction of the proposed fire department building if the construction work meets with the requirements and approval of the Kansas Department of Commerce. Therefore, the Kansas Geological Survey provides the necessary clearance from our agency for your project and I have signed the form requesting environment assessment comments.

The above discussion represents our best assessment based on the information that the Kansas Geological Survey has about this locality and/or proposed project at the time of this writing. 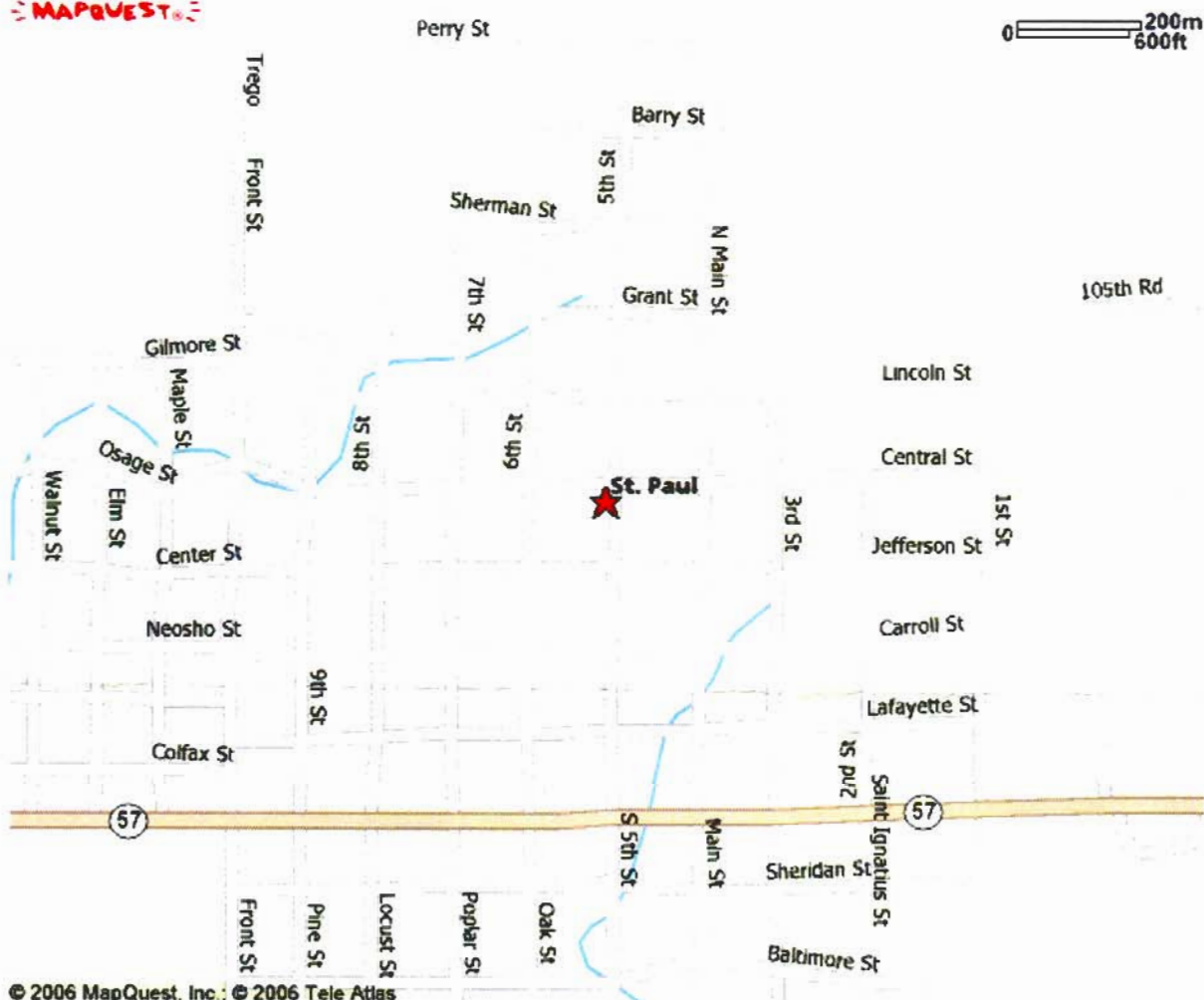
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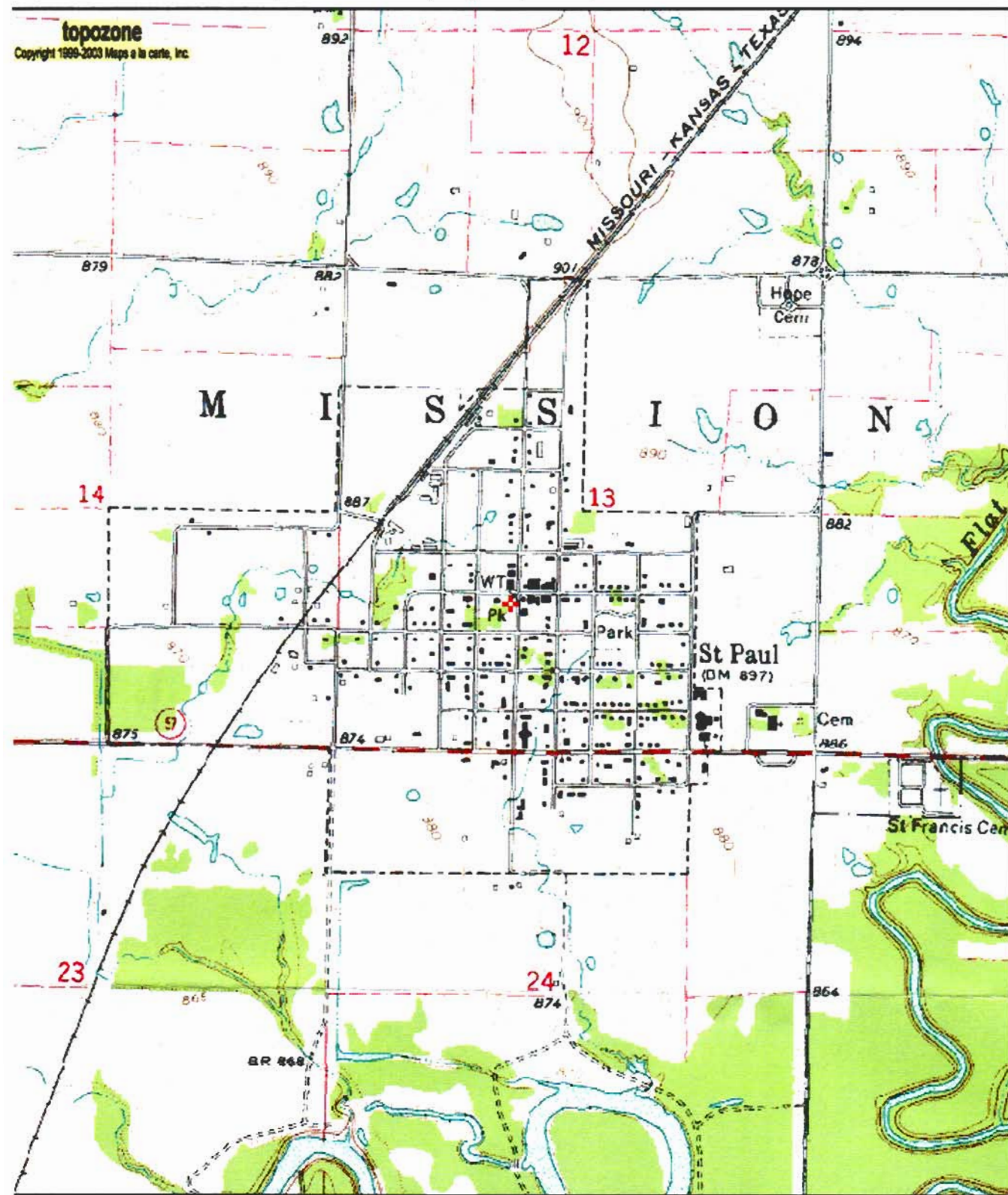
