Public Water Supply Loan Fund Capitalization Grant for Federal Fiscal Year 2007.

2. Purpose of the anticipated award and how will it benefit Kansas citizens:

The FFY 2007 Capitalization Grant will be used to continue the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund. The loan fund provides below market interest rate loans to Kansas public water suppliers.

3. Interaction with other agencies:

The Kansas Development Finance Authority will be involved with the program through an inter-agency agreement. KDFA issues state revenue bonds which will be used to provide the required 20% state matching funds and leveraged funds. The Department of Administration, Division of Accounts and Reports, provides accounting support for the loan fund, and assists with payment processing for individual loans.

5. Target date for submission of application: March 2007

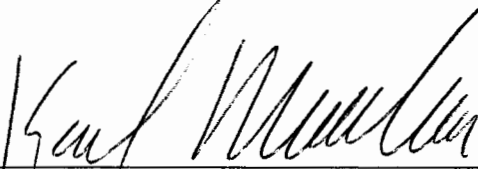

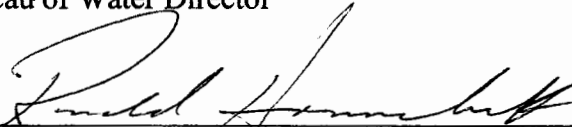

Kansas expects to receive approximately \$8,268,800 in FFY 2007 funds.

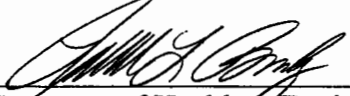

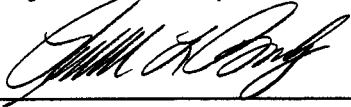
