I have reviewed the proposed project for the city of Caney, Kansas, in which improvements are to be made to their existing water treatment system.

Based on the documents attached to your request, it does not appear that there are any potential geologic hazards worth noting that might impact this project.

The above discussion represents our best assessment based on the information that the Kansas Geological Survey has about this locality and/or proposed project at the time of this writing. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the Kansas Geological Survey has no knowledge, may affect the viability or safe operation of this facility or property. The information provided in this letter is from regional or countywide studies and should not be used as a substitute for detailed site characterization by a licensed geologist or engineer. 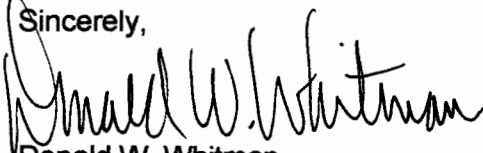
To Whom It May Concern:

The City of Caney, Kansas is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the referenced project. The project, located at SE ¼ of Section 2, Township 35S, Range 13E is necessary due to a Consent Order issued by KDHE to bring the City's new water treatment plant into compliance with drinking water by-product standards. The project will rehabilitate the existing chlorine contact basin into a presettling contact basin. The chlorine contact basin from the old water plant will be recommissioned and reused as a chlorine contact basin. A diagram depicting these changes is attached to better describe this project. The estimated cost of this project is \$900,000.

We would appreciate your review of the project description and location and any comments you may have, within thirty (30) days. A project review form is enclosed for your use.

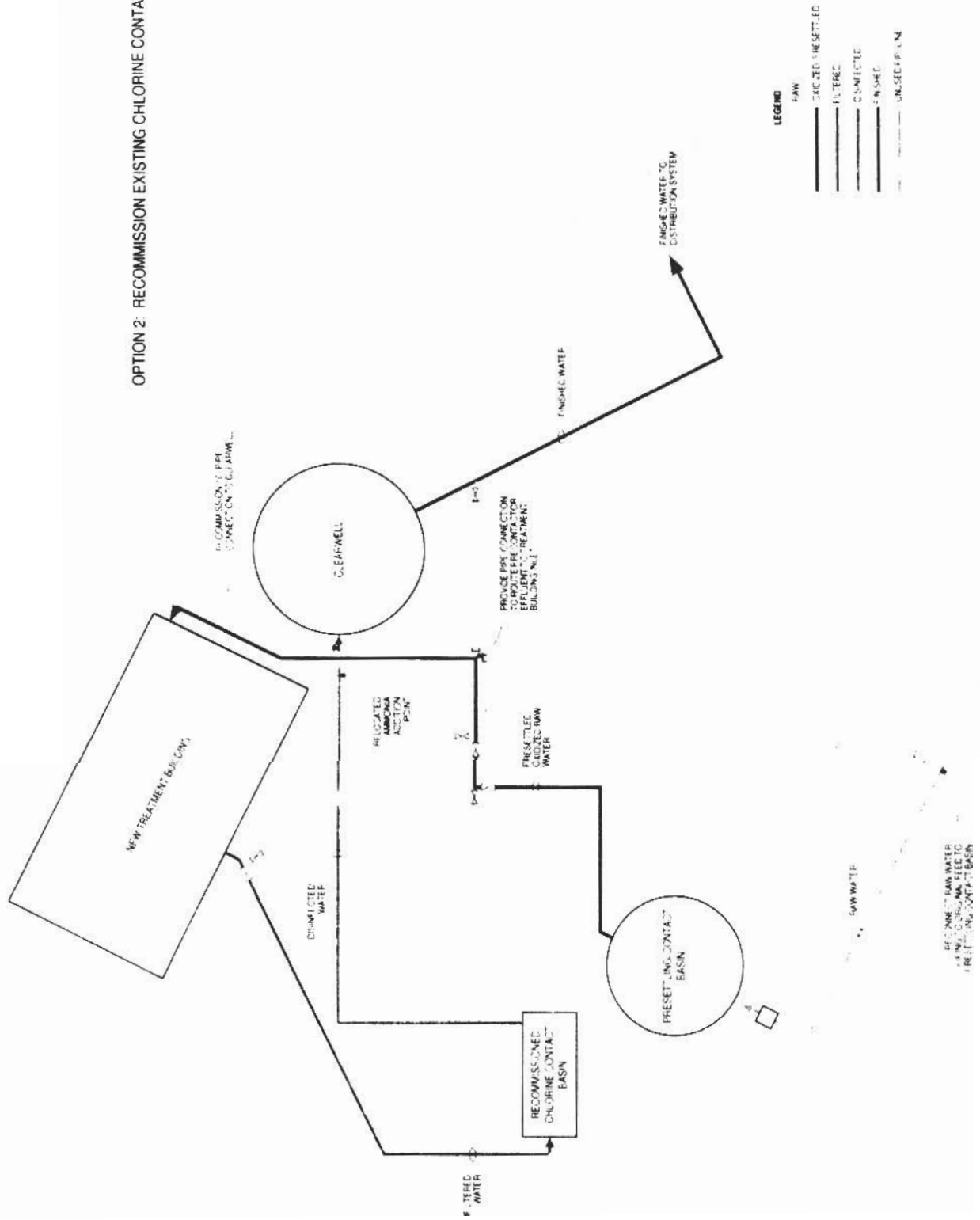

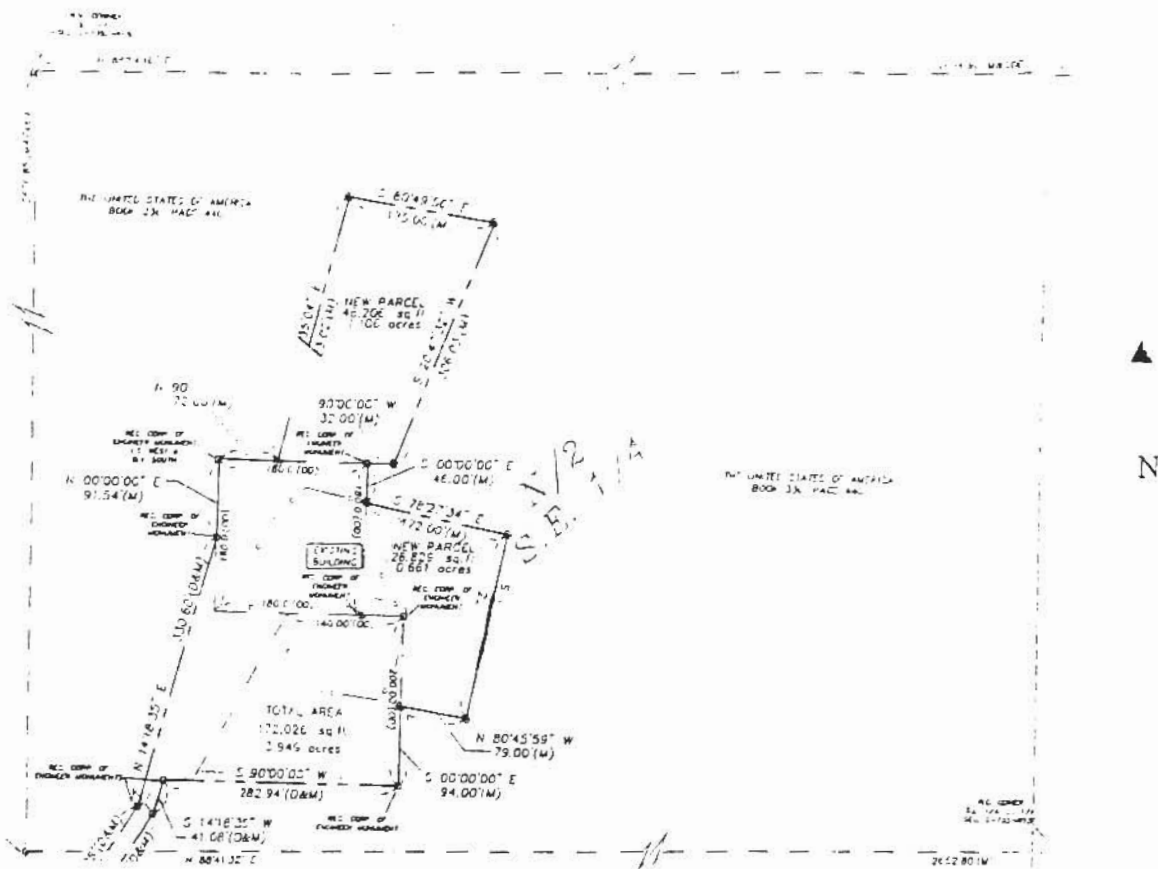
