RE: Proposed reclamation facility in sec 33, T 29S, R 37W, Grant Co., Kansas

I have examined a number of lithological logs and documents and maps regarding the proposed facility, such as Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) Bulletin 168 by Fader et al. (1964), KGS Irrigation Series 7 by Gutentag et al. (1981), the NRCS Grant Co. Soil Survey (1969), USGS topographic maps, and a number of KGS depth to water table maps and saturated thickness maps, some of which are also available at the Groundwater Management District 3 (GMD3) web site (www.gmd3.org).

The main concern I have is that this proposed site is underlain by the High Plains aquifer (or Ogallala aquifer), a major source of freshwater irrigation and drinking water in the area. Although the water table in the area is relatively deep (more than 250 ft below land surface), no confining low hydraulic conductivity layers can be detected from examination of lithologic logs in the area. If the facility is approved, protective measures need to be taken to prevent leachates from the facility reaching the underlying aquifer or nearby creeks.

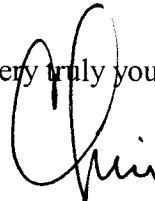
Dear Survey Staff:

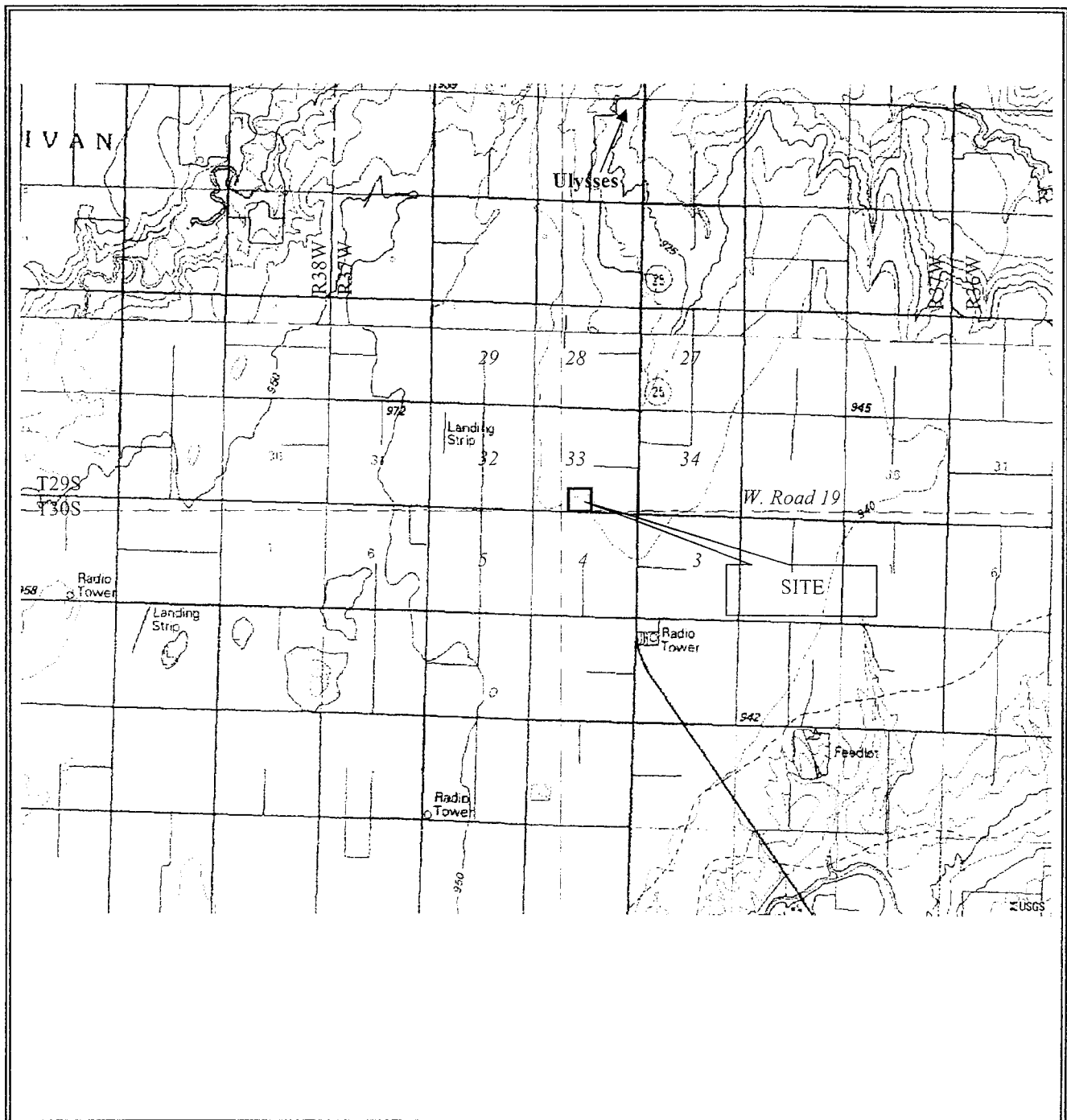

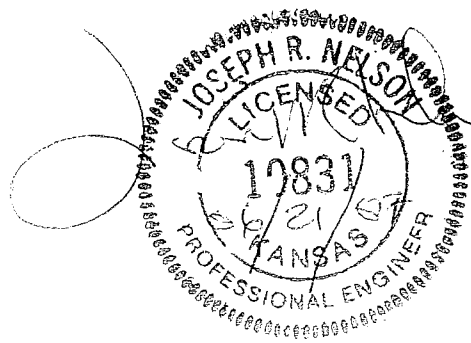
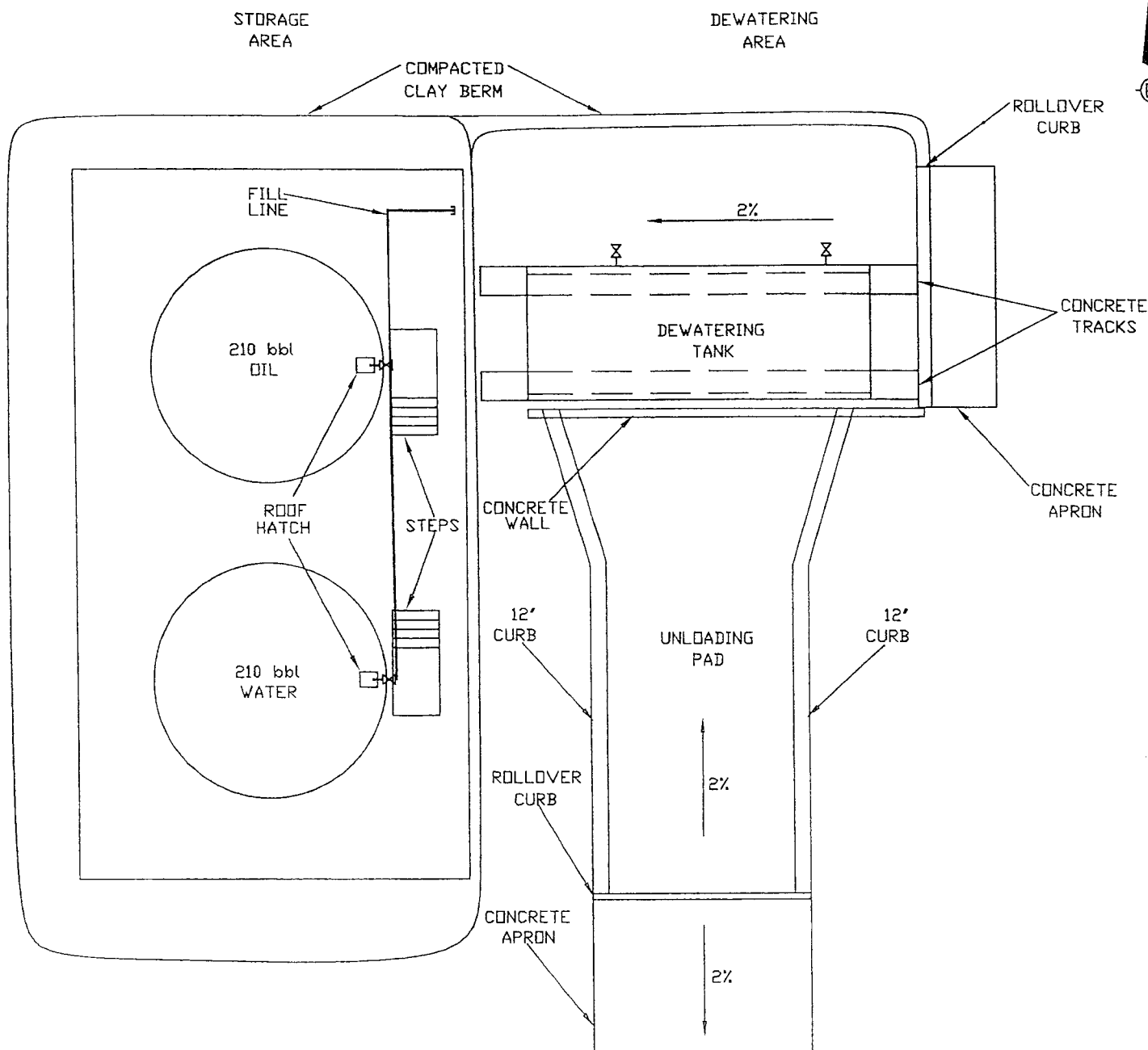
