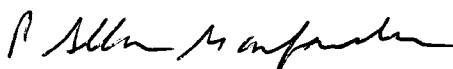
I have reviewed the proposed project to make improvements to the water distribution system for the City of Little River.

Based on the documents attached to your request, it does not appear that there are any potential geologic hazards worth noting that might impact this project.

Dear Mr. Macfarlane:

The City of Little River is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health & Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the water system improvements project. The City is also submitting an application to the Kansas Department of Commerce for Small Cities Program CDBG funds to assist in the construction of this project.

The proposed project will consist of constructing a new 6" transmission line from the well field to the city distribution system approximately 3 miles to the south, well field piping and pump improvements, new telemetry control system and replacement of 2" dead end lines to increase the pressure in the distribution system and deteriorated cast iron lines that have been repaired many times from numerous water leaks. The estimated project cost is \$792,000.00

The proposed project's transmission line extends from the chlorination building in the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 29, T18S, R6W to the City of Little River in Section 17, T19S, R6W all in Rice County, Kansas. The attached map shows the approximately location for your use. It is proposed to install the water line in the existing right-of-way and in public right-of-way. The Arkansas River crossing will be directionally bored.

No persons will need to be relocated due to the construction of this project. If there are any special permits or conditions that apply, please let us know. We would appreciate receiving your comments by August 26, 2007 regarding this project. A Project Review Form has been enclosed for your convenience.
