I have reviewed the proposed project to make improvements to the infrastructure for Marion Co. Improvement District 2.

Marion County Improvement District No. 2, Marion County, Kansas is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health & Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the water system improvements project.

The proposed project will consist of constructing a 75,000 gallon elevated water tower, complete, 1,000' of 8" PVC water line, two 8" valves & boxes, one road crossing, connect to the existing system and telemetry system modifications.. The estimated project cost is \$500,000.

The proposed tower project is located on Lots 34 & 40, Echo Lane Subdivision in the SW/4 quarter, Section 10, Township 20 South, Range 4 East, Marion County, Kansas (near the intersection of Hillcrest and Ridgeway on the east side of the lake). The approximate latitude and longitude are: 38°19'15.81" N and 96°58'36.53"W. Elevation of the site is 1354 MSL. Enclosed for your information are copies of the Improvement District Map and the project location map.

The District has acquired the property for the tower site and the water line easement will be in public right-of-way. No persons will need to be relocated due to the construction of this project. If there are any special permits or conditions that apply, please let us know.

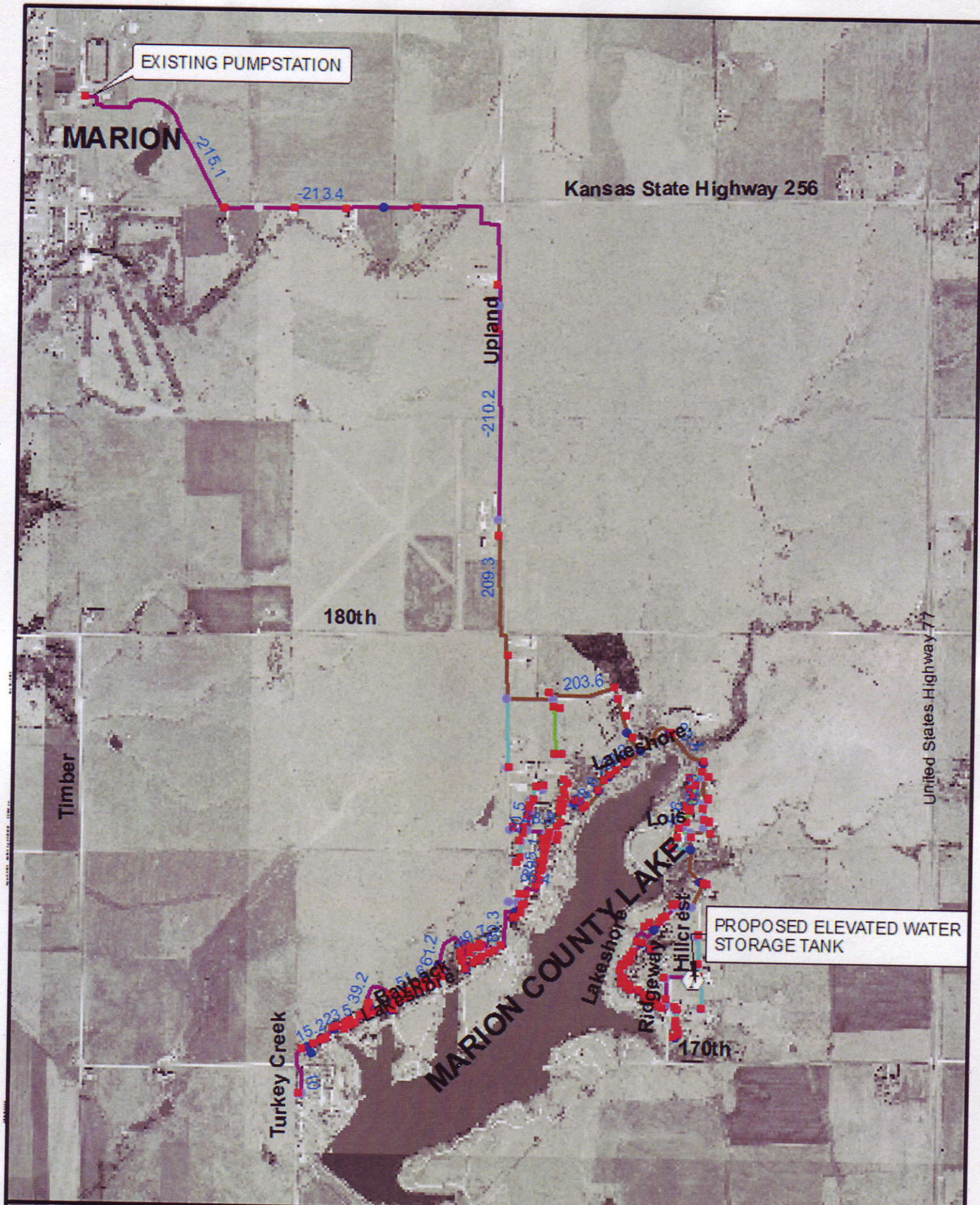
