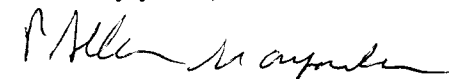
I have reviewed the proposed project to construct a new water plant for the City of Lecompton, Kansas.

Based on the documents attached to your request, it does not appear that there are any potential geologic hazards worth noting that might impact this project.

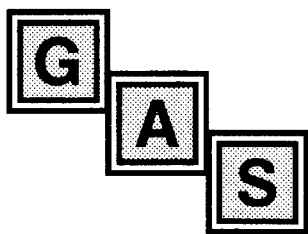

Dear Dr. Harrison:

On March 29, 2007 the City of Lecompton, KS submitted information to your department to obtain comments and clearance of the above-named project. Originally, the new plant was to be constructed within the SE quarter of Section 34, Township 11 South and Range 18 East.

The city has concluded that the location at 302 Clark Street is much better because there is more flexibility to enlarge later if needed.

The boundary description is in Section 34, Township 11, Range 18, SE/4 beginning 816' N and 40' E of SW Corner SE/4, E 261', S 90', E 272', N 313.5', W 272', S 100', W 261', S 123.5' to POB. (Please note the attached maps and schematic drawing.)

The project costs of \$1,190,000 have not changed, \$400,000 is a KDOC grant and \$790,000 will be financed by Rural Development.
