Dear Ms. Thielen:

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received the North Central Regional Planning Commission's (Commission) April 23, 2008, request for environmental comments to a revised scope of work. The City of Wilson has received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and a KDHE Public Water Supply Loan to finance improvements to the City's public water supply system (PWS). Project work will include replacement of old iron waterlines with new PCV pipe from the City well to selected distribution lines within the City. The project was recently revised to include additional distribution lines in the City. The project is located within and north of Wilson, Ellsworth County, KS.

A review of regional geologic information along with site maps provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project, so clearance of the project should be granted. An environmental review form was not submitted; therefore, this letter should serve as the completed agency review.

This letter is an assessment based on the regional geologic conditions available at the KGS at the time of writing and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability or safe operation of this facility or property. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

You recently responded to an environmental review request for a waterline replacement project in the City of Wilson. The project is being funded by a Community Development Block Grant and a KDHE Public Water Supply Loan. Since receiving your response, the city has approved expanding the scope of work of the project. The revised scope of work now includes replacing a few additional sections of distribution lines within the city limits that were not part of the original project. The new distribution lines will replace existing lines — nothing new will be disturbed. The additional failing sections of line within town that are being proposed to replace include the following:

- on D Street from 21st to 23rd
- a small section on C Street around 22nd
- a section of line on I street between 22nd and 24th

A map is attached. The orange highlighting indicates distribution lines that were part of the original work that have already been reviewed with your previous comments. The blue highlighting indicates the additional lines the city is proposing to replace as described above.
