Re: New central kitchen and dining facility for Methodist Youthville

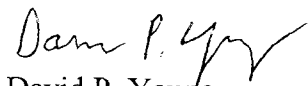
Dear Ms. Huelskamp,

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your letter dated June 25, 2008, requesting us to review the above referenced project. The project consists of the construction of a 60' x 120' metal building on the Methodist Youthville campus at 11200 Lariat Way in Dodge City (SW ¼ Sec. 31, T.26S., R.24W). The building will be located between two existing buildings, as illustrated on the map you provided.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. The site is located in the Arkansas River alluvium. However, according to the USDA Ford County Soil Survey, the Canadian fine sandy loam at this particular site is seldom flooded. According to the Soil Survey, depth to the water table ranges from 7 to 15 feet, which may influence foundation design. These site-specific conditions should be considered prior to construction.

This letter is an assessment based on the regional geologic conditions available at the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

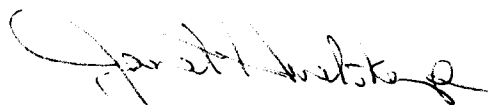
