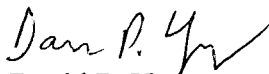
Dear Ms. Ohlde,

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your August 28, 2008 letter requesting us to review the above referenced project. The project consists of replacing old water lines with new ones in the City of Greenleaf. Boring will be necessary in 3 locations.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. However, WWC-5 water well records indicate that there are two environmental sites along with their associated monitoring wells within the City of Greenleaf – owned by the Farmers/Greenleaf Coop. Depending on the proximity of these sites to the alignment, trenching and/or boring activities sometimes may either encounter off-site contaminant migration or monitoring wells. Monitoring wells are usually installed in road right-of-way easements or on private property, but exact locations cannot be verified from WWC-5 records. The applicant should be aware of the proximity of the sites and monitoring wells so they can be addressed if they are encountered during construction. A completed agency review form is enclosed.

This letter is an assessment based on information about the regional geologic conditions available via the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

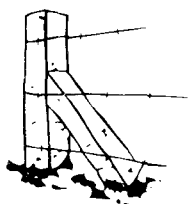

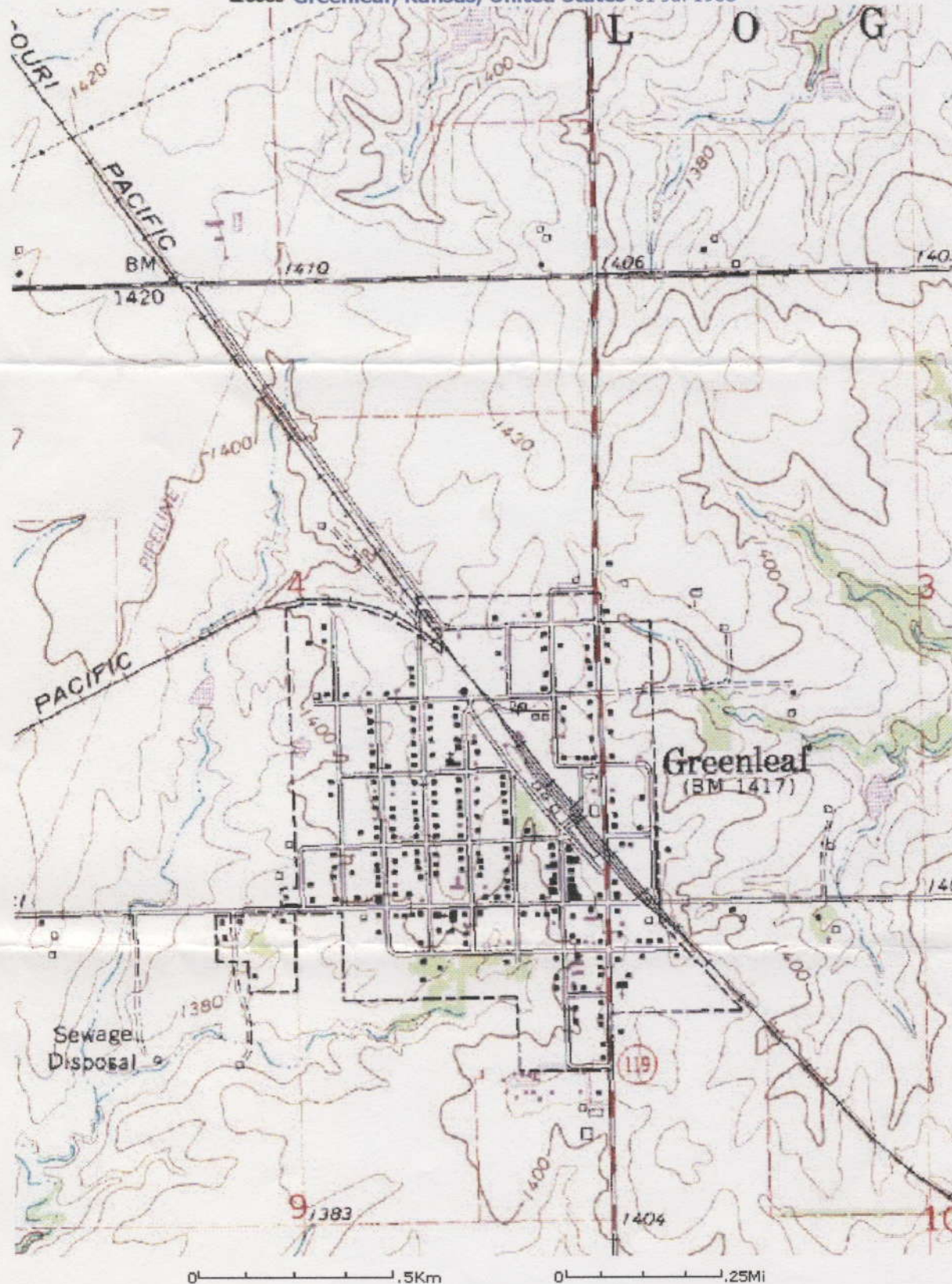
