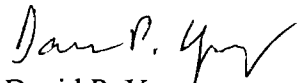
Dear Ms Naden,

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your request for us to review the above referenced project. The project involves the acquisition of up to four (4) improved properties located in the City of Coffeyville's Flood Zone A. The current owners of the properties are participating in this buyout program on a voluntary basis. Once the properties are acquired by the City, all improvements will be demolished and the properties will be maintained as open space.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. Environmental factors that could affect this project will likely be more site-specific in nature or dependent on the structure (e.g., asbestos, lead paint, USTs, etc.). Site-specific factors should be considered in the environmental review process. A completed request for environmental comments form is enclosed.

This letter is an assessment based on information about the regional geologic conditions available via the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

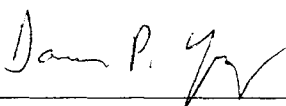

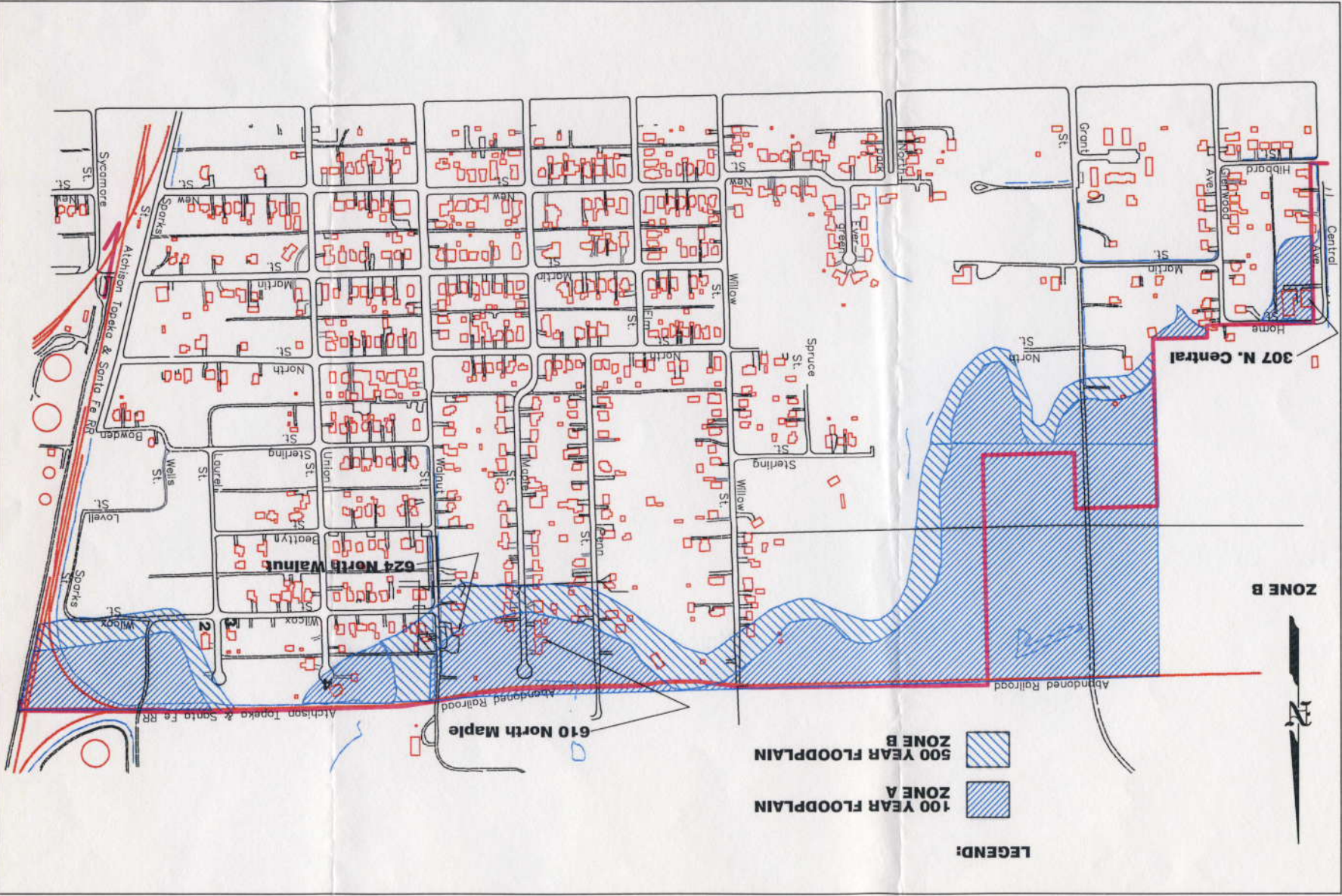

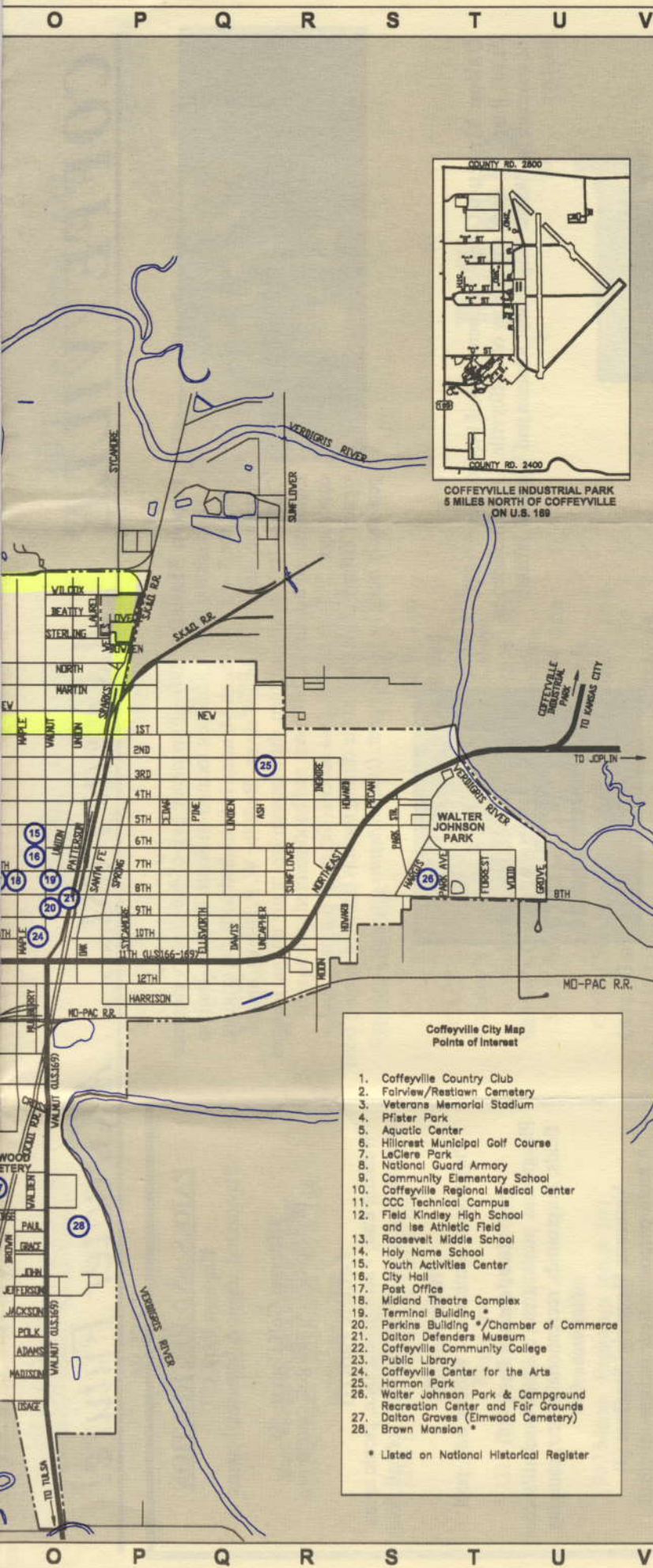
