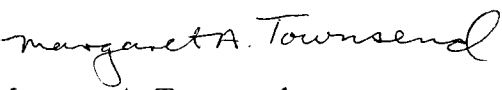

I have reviewed the information provided to me concerning the City of Liberty improvements to the sanitary sewer system. Based on the information provided to me the project looks sound and should be approved.

The above comments are based on regional geologic conditions and limited information available to the KGS at the time of writing and cannot be used in substitute for a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed here, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability or safe operation of this facility or property. Geotechnical engineering and design are outside the purview of the KGS. It is the responsibility of the applicant to produce any detailed site characterizations, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.
