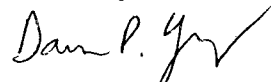
Dear Ms. Galemore,

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your request for us to review the above referenced project. The project will consist of removing and replacing deteriorated water lines and valves within the city limits of Humboldt, Kansas.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. However, it should be noted that portions of the City of Humboldt are located in a 100-year flood zone. A FEMA flood insurance rate index map is enclosed. Also enclosed is a completed agency review form.

This letter is an assessment based on information about the regional geologic conditions available via the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

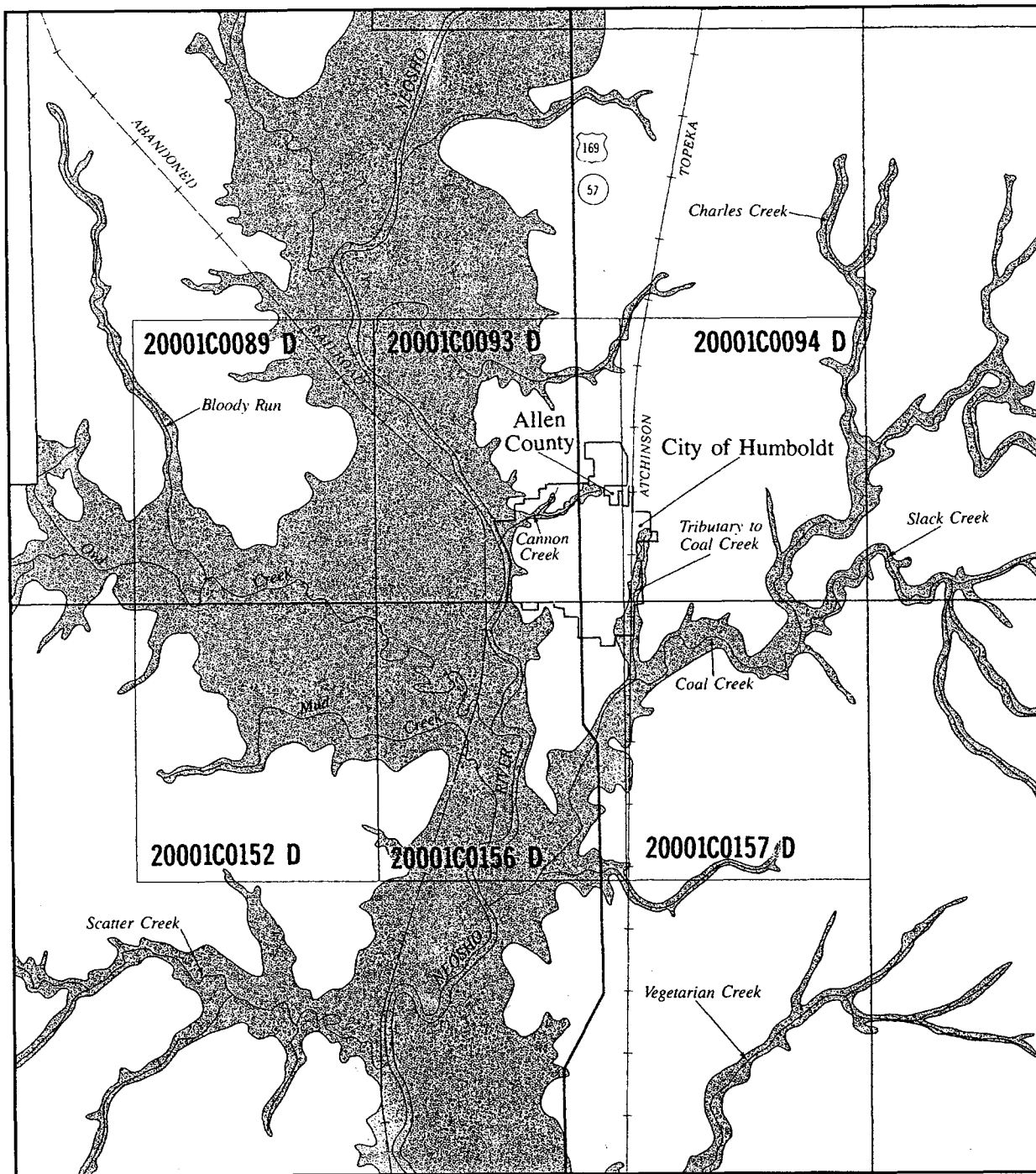

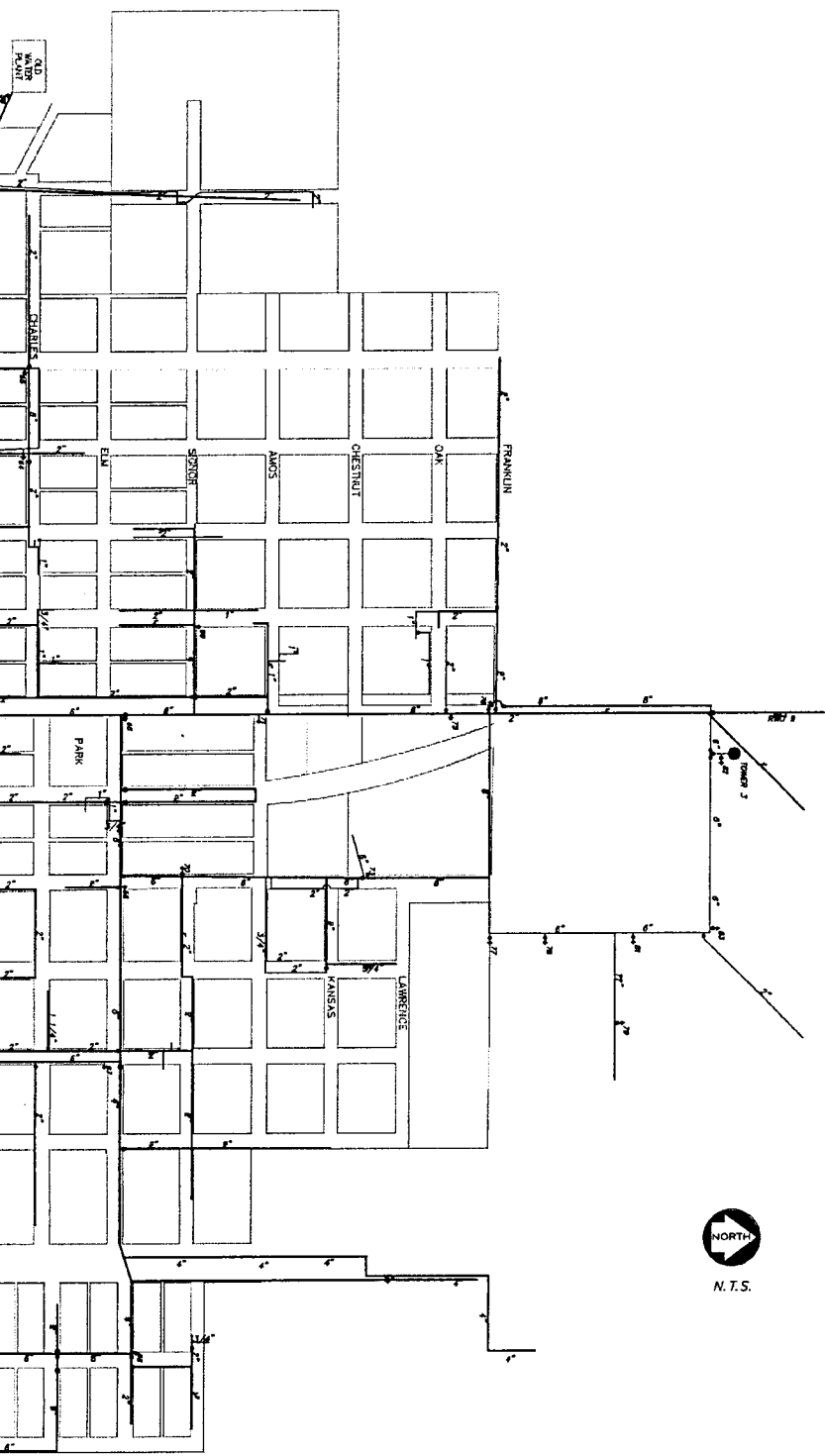


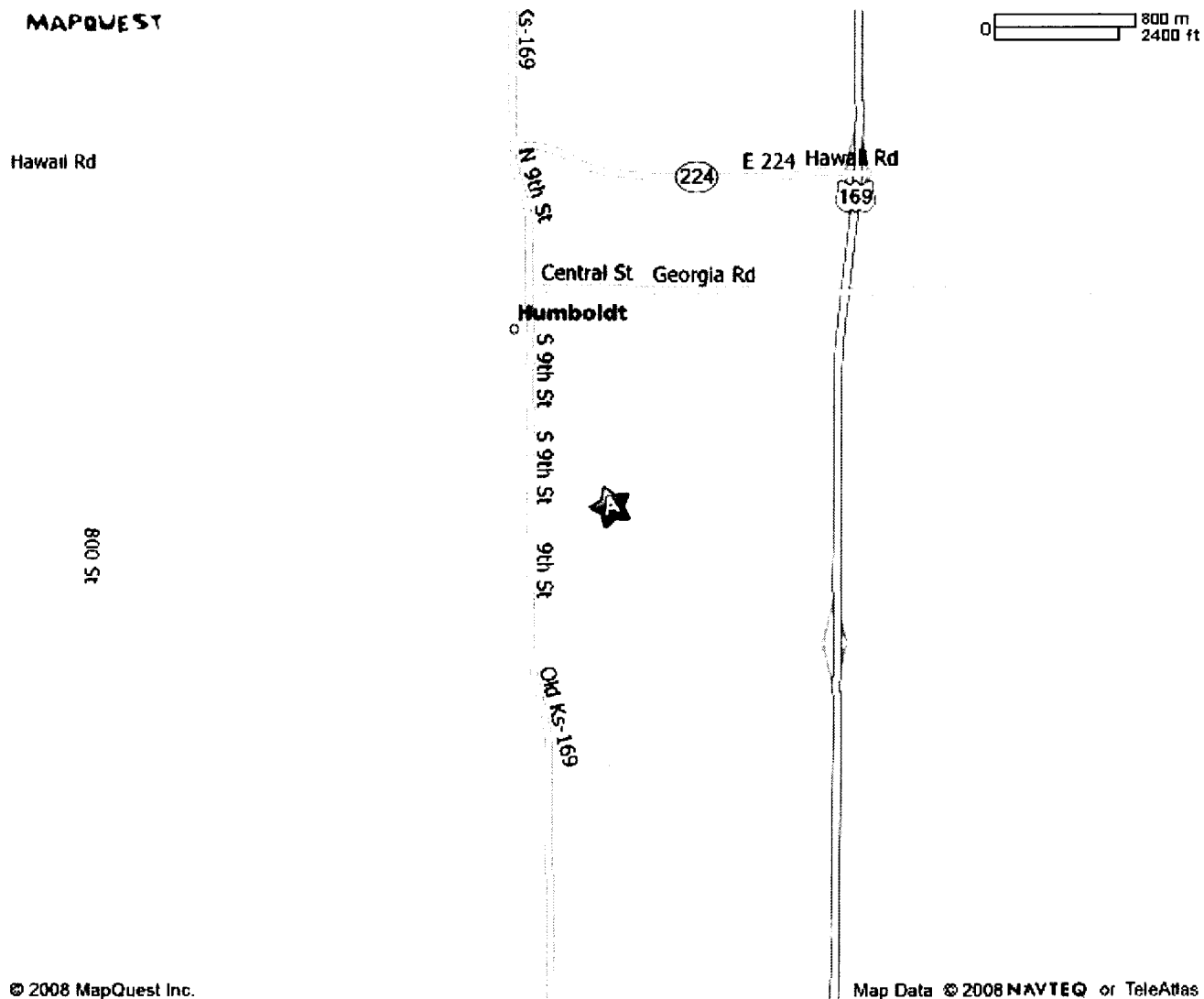
