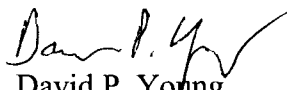
Dear Mr. Emert,

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your July 31, 2008 letter requesting us to review the above referenced project. The project will consist of replacing 2" through 10" water lines. All of the construction will be within the City Limits of Cherryvale.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. Site-specific conditions should be considered prior to construction.

This letter is an assessment based on the regional geologic conditions available at the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

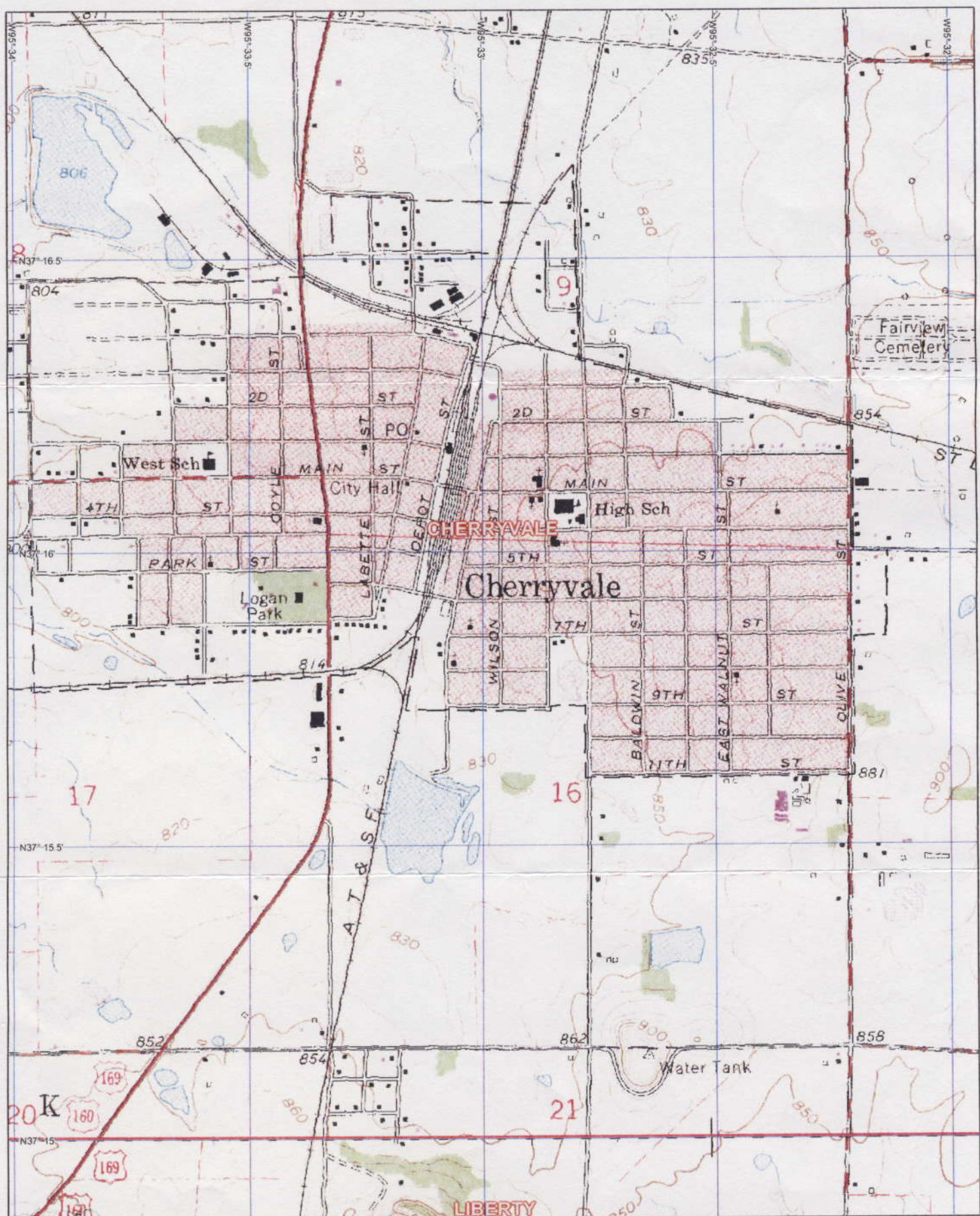
