I have reviewed the proposed projects described in your letters of April 28 and April 30, 2008, in which you describe improvements to be made to your water treatment plant and water distribution system.

Based on the documents attached to your request, it does not appear that there are any potential geologic hazards worth noting that might impact this project.

The above discussion represents our best assessment based on the information that the Kansas Geological Survey has about this locality and/or proposed project at the time of this writing. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the Kansas Geological Survey has no knowledge, may affect the viability or safe operation of this facility or property. The information provided in this letter is from regional or countywide studies and should not be used as a substitute for detailed site characterization by a licensed geologist or engineer. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any required site characterizations.

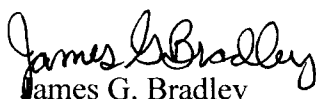

To Whom It May Concern;

The City of Ottawa is preparing an application to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for a loan from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund for the referenced project. The proposed project will construct a new 16" waterline all within a developed area of the City of Ottawa beginning at the intersection of Willow and 2nd Street in the Northeast ¼ of Section 35, Township 16 S, Range 19 E of the 6th Principal Meridian, City of Ottawa, Franklin County, Kansas, running North along the Willow Street right-of-way to a point on the North side of the abandoned railroad right-of-way, then turning in a Northeasterly direction and boring under the Marais des Cygnes River at an angle to a point on the North side of the River located within Forest Park, then Northeasterly to Locust Street, then running North along the west side of Locust Street right-of-way to a point South of the Forest Street intersection, crossing Locust Street in a Northeasterly direction, continuing North along the East side of Locust Street to the intersection of West Wilson and Locust Streets, then turning East and continuing along Wilson Street to Main Street, turning North on the West side of Main Street to Dundee Street, turning East along Dundee to Hickory, then turning South along Hickory Street to the existing water tower in the Northeast ¼ of Section 25, Township 16S, Range 19 E all within a developed area of the City of Ottawa.
