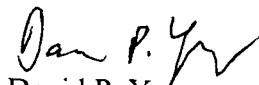
Dear Mr./Ms. Meinen,

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your March 27, 2009 letter requesting us to review the above referenced project. The proposed project consists of constructing approximately 6,100 feet of 12" water line located in Sections 13 and 24, Township 34 South, Range 3 East.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. However, it should be noted that a portion of the project may cross a flood zone. A FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map is enclosed for reference. Site-specific conditions should be considered prior to construction. A completed agency review form is enclosed.

This letter is an assessment based on information about the regional geologic conditions available via the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

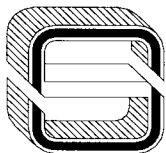
