The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your request asking us to review the above referenced project. In general, the project involves replacement of existing waterlines and construction of 11,170 L.F. of new water mains in Frontenac, Kansas.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. The project may encounter remains of past coal mining activities. Site-specific conditions should be considered prior to construction.

This letter is an assessment based on the regional geologic conditions available at the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

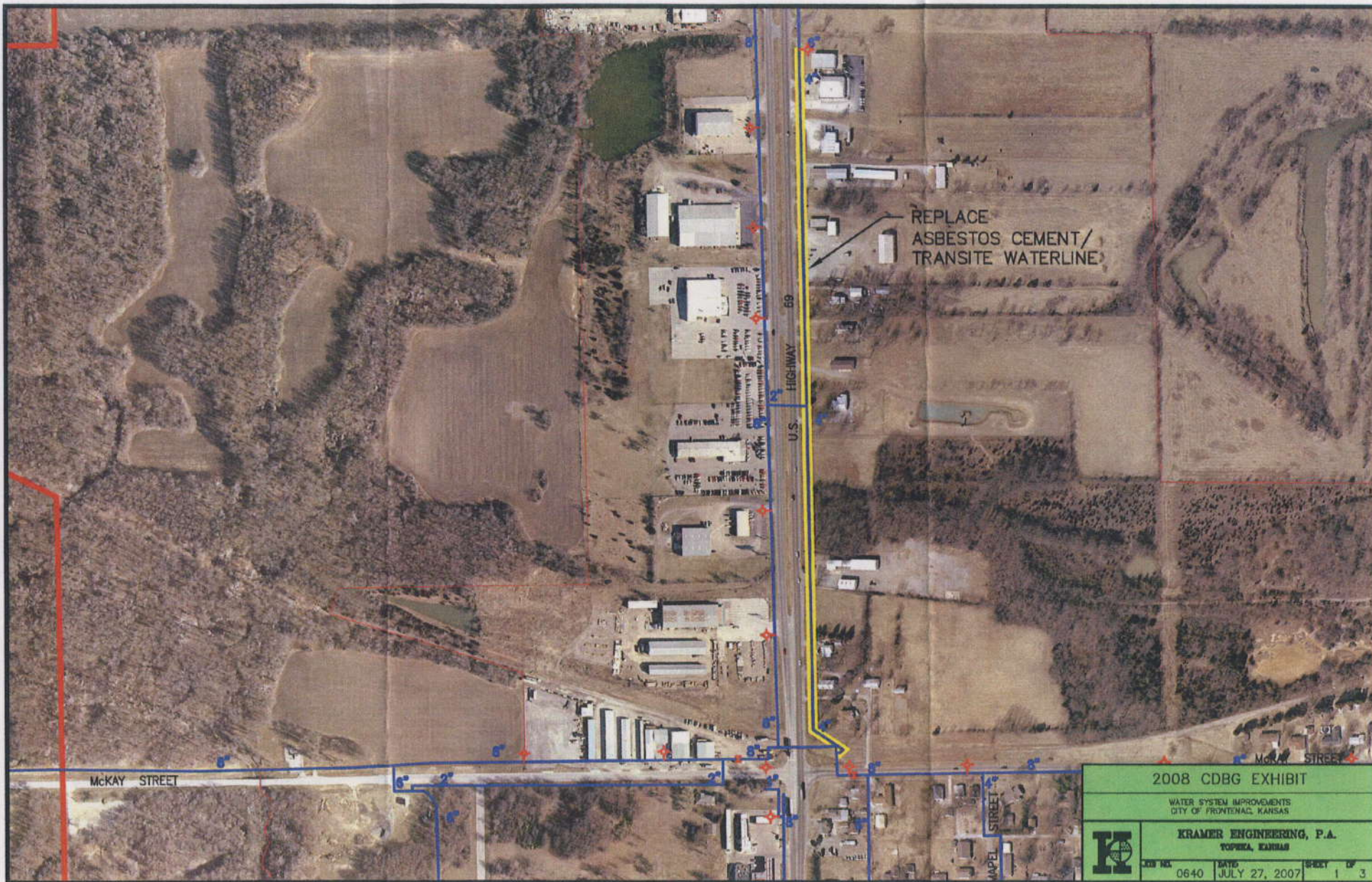

The City of Frontenac, Kansas has received a CDBG Water Grant from the Kansas Department of Commerce for financial assistance in the total approximate amount of \$375,525 for the replacement of existing waterlines and installing approximately 11,170 L.F. of 8" water mains, 27 valves, 14 fire hydrants, water meters, and appurtenances to improve the existing water quality and flow.

This waterline replacement project will be completely within the city limits of Frontenac, Crawford County, Kansas. More specifically, the waterline located along the east side of Highway 69, from McKay Street north approximately 2,600' is served by an existing Asbestos Cement/Transite Waterline, and the waterlines located on the west side of Highway 69/Parkview Drive from approximately 130' south of Harris Street to 1,400' south of Leighton Street, and the waterline located on the north side of Leighton Street from Highway 69/Parkview Drive to Cayuga Street is a cast iron.

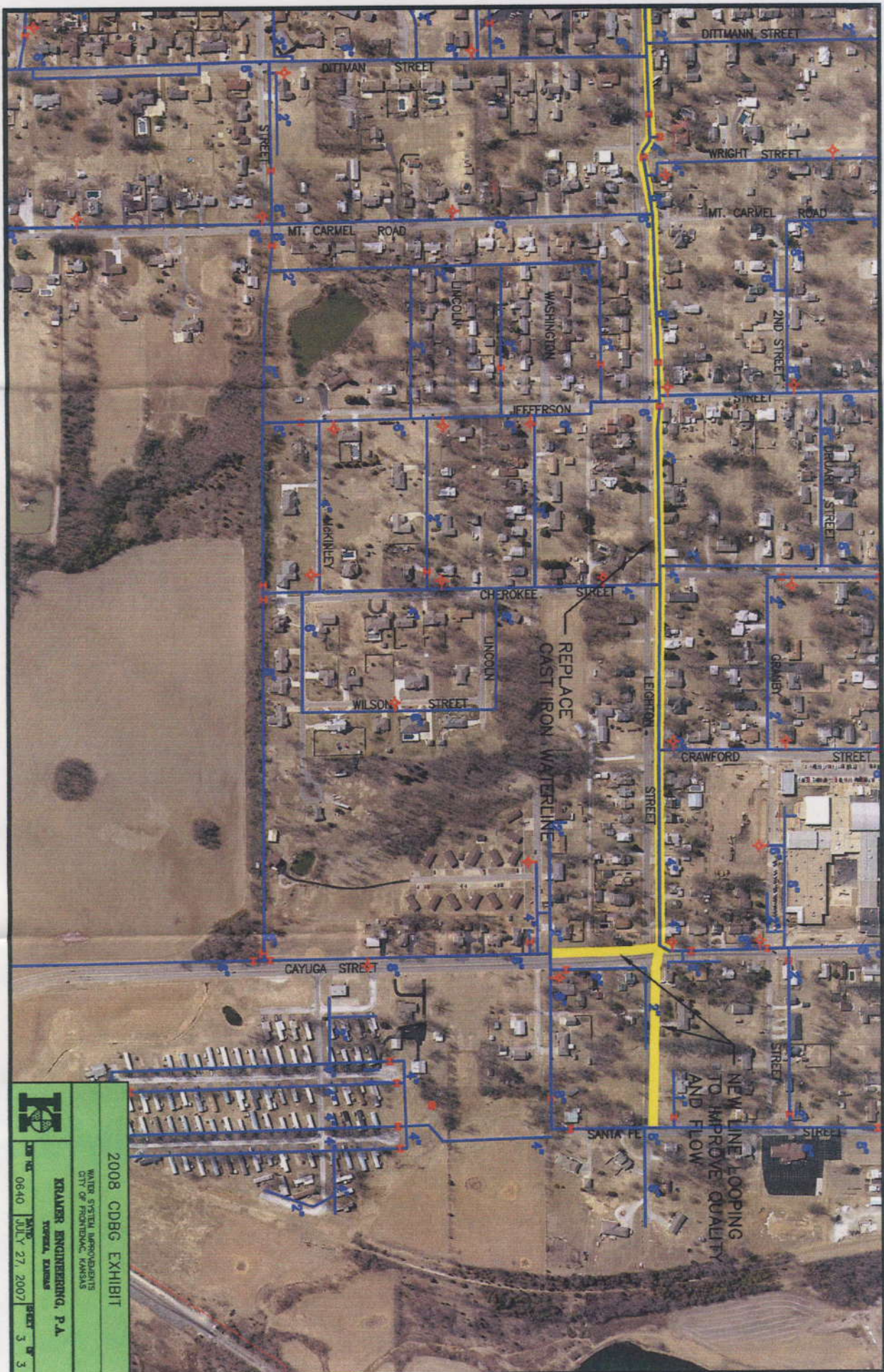
