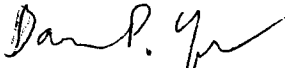
Dear Mr. Nordstrom,

The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received your June 9, 2009 letter requesting us to review the above referenced project. The project involves street improvements within the City of Burlingame.

A review of regional geologic information and project information provided by you indicates that there are no unduly adverse geologic conditions that should affect this project. However, WWC5 records at the KGS indicate the presence of several monitoring wells located within the city limits. These wells could indicate environmental sites. Site-specific conditions should be considered prior to any construction.

This letter is an assessment based on information about the regional geologic conditions available via the KGS and cannot be used in substitute of a detailed site characterization. Other geologic conditions, not discussed herein, or for which the KGS has no knowledge, may affect the viability of the project. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide any necessary characterization, geotechnical or environmental testing, or design by a licensed professional geologist or engineer to complete the project.

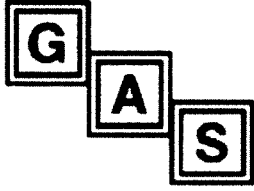

The City of Burlingame, KS is preparing a Community Development Block Grant application for a street renovation project within the city limits or Section 10, 11, 15, 14, Township 15 south, Range 14 east of Osage County, KS. The application will be submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce. Final design plans have not yet been completed but a total cost has been estimated to be approximately 500,000.
