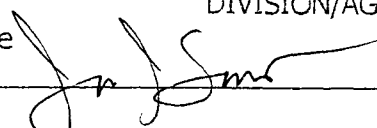

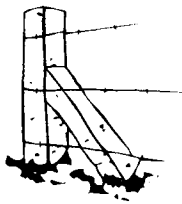

To Whom It May Concern:

Marshall County has been awarded grant funds from the Kansas Department of Commerce's Community Facilities Community Development Block Grant division to demolish and replace four existing deteriorating bridges in rural areas of the county. The County believes the bridges are no longer satisfactory for the current roadway usage. The county opts to demolish and remove the existing structures and replace them with a pre-engineered modular bridge design they have implemented successfully in the past.

The County is able to contribute \$122,210 (half) of the estimated \$244,407 total cost. The County's contribution will be primarily in the form of force account labor and equipment use.

Enclosed is a project summary and location maps. Your agency comment on this subject is important. Please respond with comments on or before thirty days from the date of this letter, July 15, 2009. Please note that, under separate cover, the County will also be seeking comment and permits on specific plans for specific bridges as is normally required on bridge replacement projects. This activity is occurring concurrently to this process to achieve general release of funds from the Kansas Department of Commerce.
