PROGRAM ACTIVITY/DESCRIPTION:

Currently, an environmental assessment is being conducted on the overall activities of the Phase II Water System Improvements. This project will consist of the rehabilitation of the hand dug cistern well or new water well construction within 100' of existing well (option most economical), pump controls, cistern well abandonment (if needed), dismantling of existing well house, chlorination system and electrical improvements.

Also 600 LF of 4" waterline removed and replaced, 4 - 4" fittings, 4 abandon main, 4 connect to existing, 3 - 4" Gate Valve w/ box, 1 fire hydrant, 600 LF of tracer wire, 7 - 1" waterline connections, 350 LF of 1" service lines, and remove and replace 7 water meters.
