The Kansas Geological Survey (KGS) has received Professional Engineering Consultants June 24, 2009, request for environmental comments for the above referenced project. The City of Osage City has submitted a grant application to the Kansas Department of Commerce for a dam rehabilitation project at the Osage City Lake. The project will bring the dam in compliance with Kansas Department of Agriculture, Division of Water Resource rules and regulations.

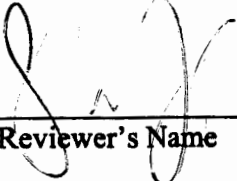

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The City of Osage City has submitted an application to the Kansas Department of Commerce for a CDBG – R Grant for the Dam Rehabilitation of the Osage City Lake. The project is needed to bring the existing Dam into compliance with current Kansas Department of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources (DWR) rules and requirements. The proposed improvements include the rehabilitation of the existing concrete spillway, the construction of a stilling basin downstream of the spillway, the raising, extending and rehabilitation of the existing earthen embankment, and construction of a flood wall along a portion of the embankment (See Figure 2). The proposed work addresses maintenance issues and freeboard requirements above the existing pool level, with only minor impacts to the existing project footprint.

The proposed work is located in the Northwest ¼ of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 14 East of the 6th Principal Meridian in Osage County, Kansas (See Figure 1). To assist with the understanding, nature and extent of the proposed project we have prepared a number of attachments to this letter as follows:
