Plate 3--Thin sections showing attrital coal. **A**, Banded translucent attritus. Wide band near center is classified as anthraxylon on basis of size (Mineral coal, X 125). **B**, Translucent attritus composed of shredlike fragments. Opaque bodies are pyrite (Mineral coal, X 125). **C**, Opaque attritus intercalcated with bands of anthraxylon and translucent attritus (Bevier coal, X 95).

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
