Plate 9--Calcite in "coal balls." **A**, Photomicrograph of a coal ball taken with a reflecting microscope using obliquely incident light. The material in the center of the boxlike cells is calcite; the original woody plant material is preserved in cell walls (X 80). **B**, Same, showing different section of plant cells (X 85).
