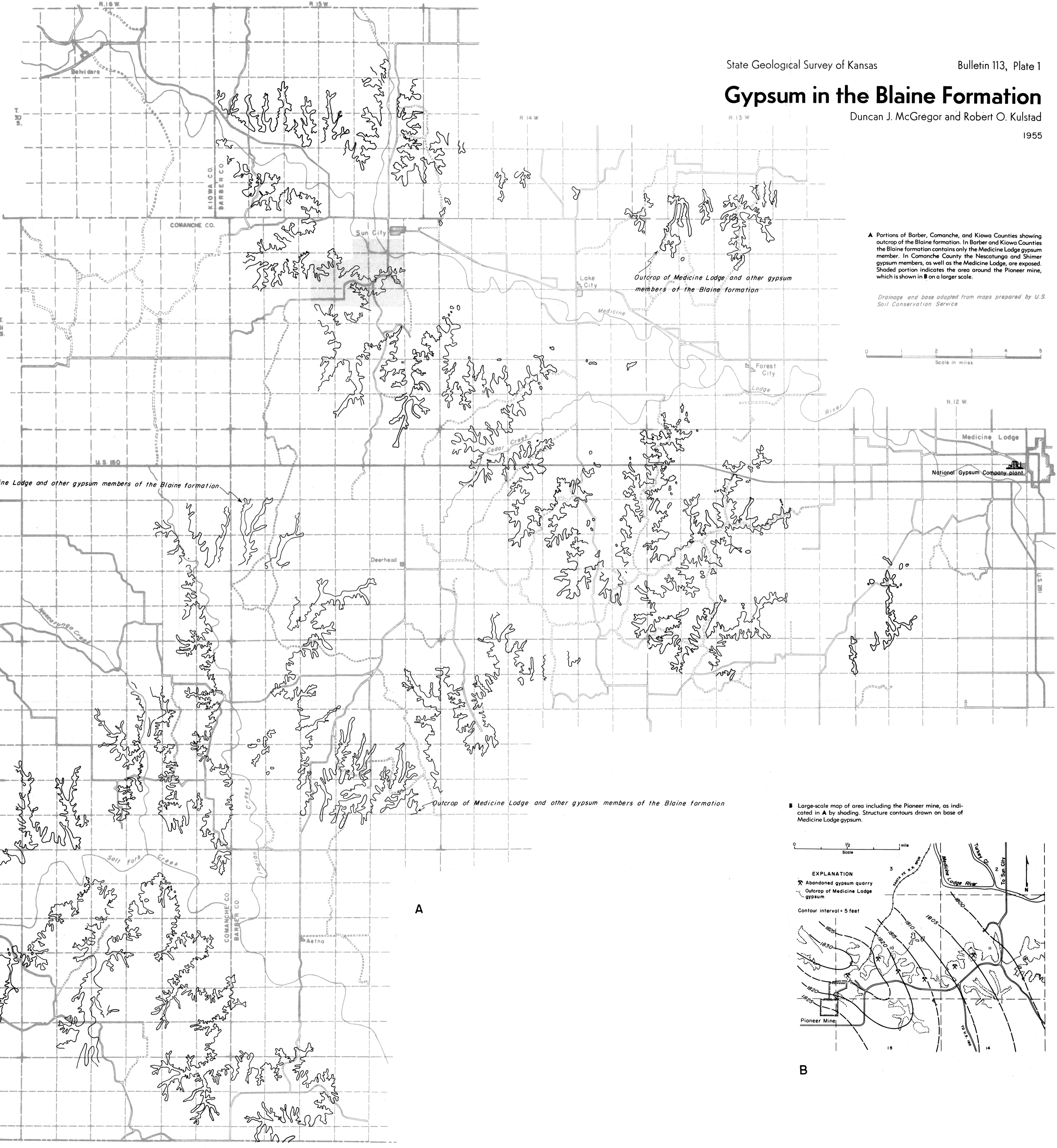


Gypsum in the Blaine Formation

In Comanche County the Nescatunga and Shimer gypsum members, as well as the Medicine Lodge, are exposed. Shaded portion indicates the area around the Pioneer mine, which is shown in B on a larger scale.

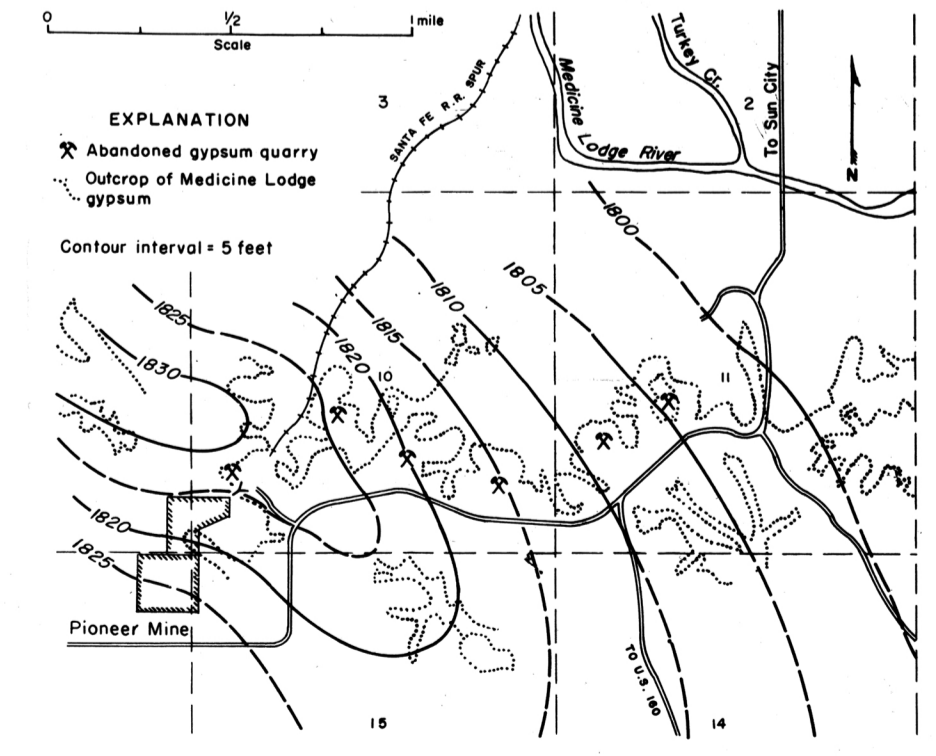
