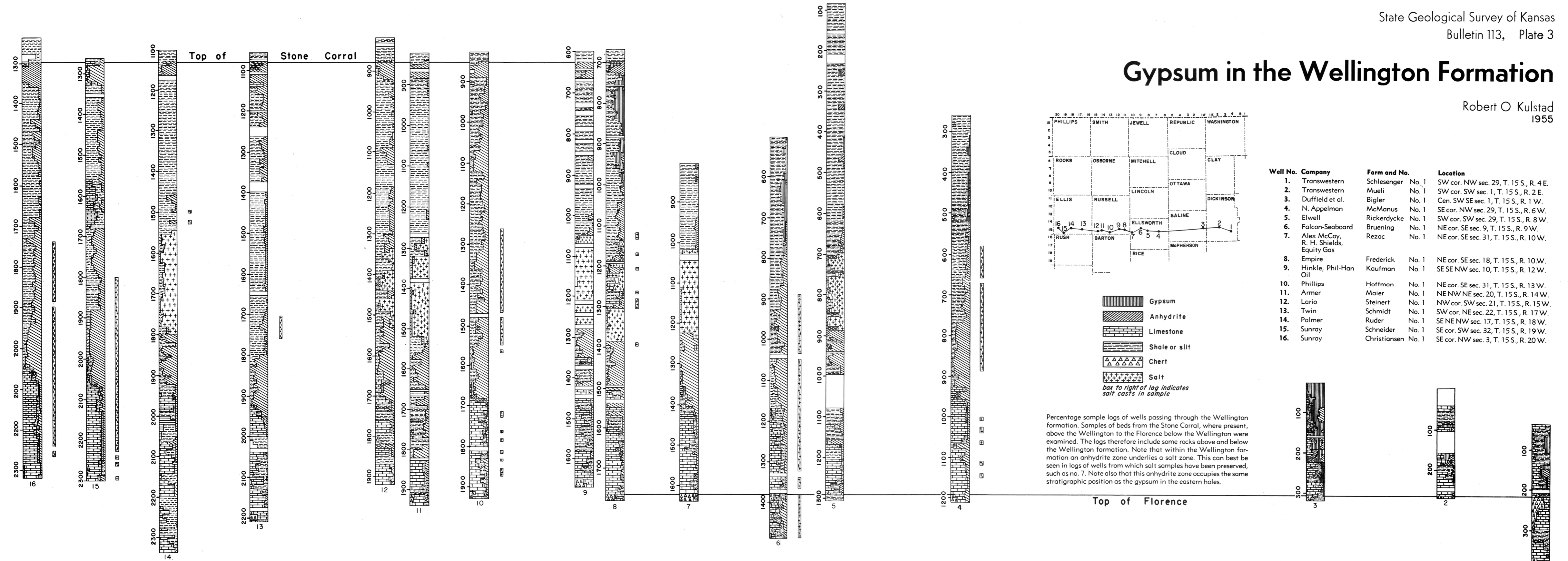


Gypsum in the Wellington Formation

Percentage sample logs of wells passing through the Wellington formation. Samples of beds from the Stone Corral, where present, above the Wellington to the Florence below the Wellington were examined. The logs therefore include some rocks above and below the Wellington formation. Note that within the Wellington formation an anhydrite zone underlies a salt zone. This can best be seen in logs of wells from which salt samples have been preserved, such as no. 7. Note also that this anhydrite zone occupies the same stratigraphic position as the gypsum in the eastern holes.
