

Weekly production of oil in Kansas, April, 1916, to October, 1917.

The increase late in October, 1916, was due to the remarkable new wells in the Tow and a district, El Dorado field, Butler county. The sudden increase in production in June, 1917, and the steady rise from July to October are due to the great development and remarkable flow of the new wells from this same district.
