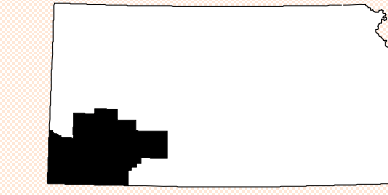


SATURATED THICKNESS AT SECTION CENTERS IN THE HIGH PLAINS AQUIFER PREDEVELOPMENT DATA



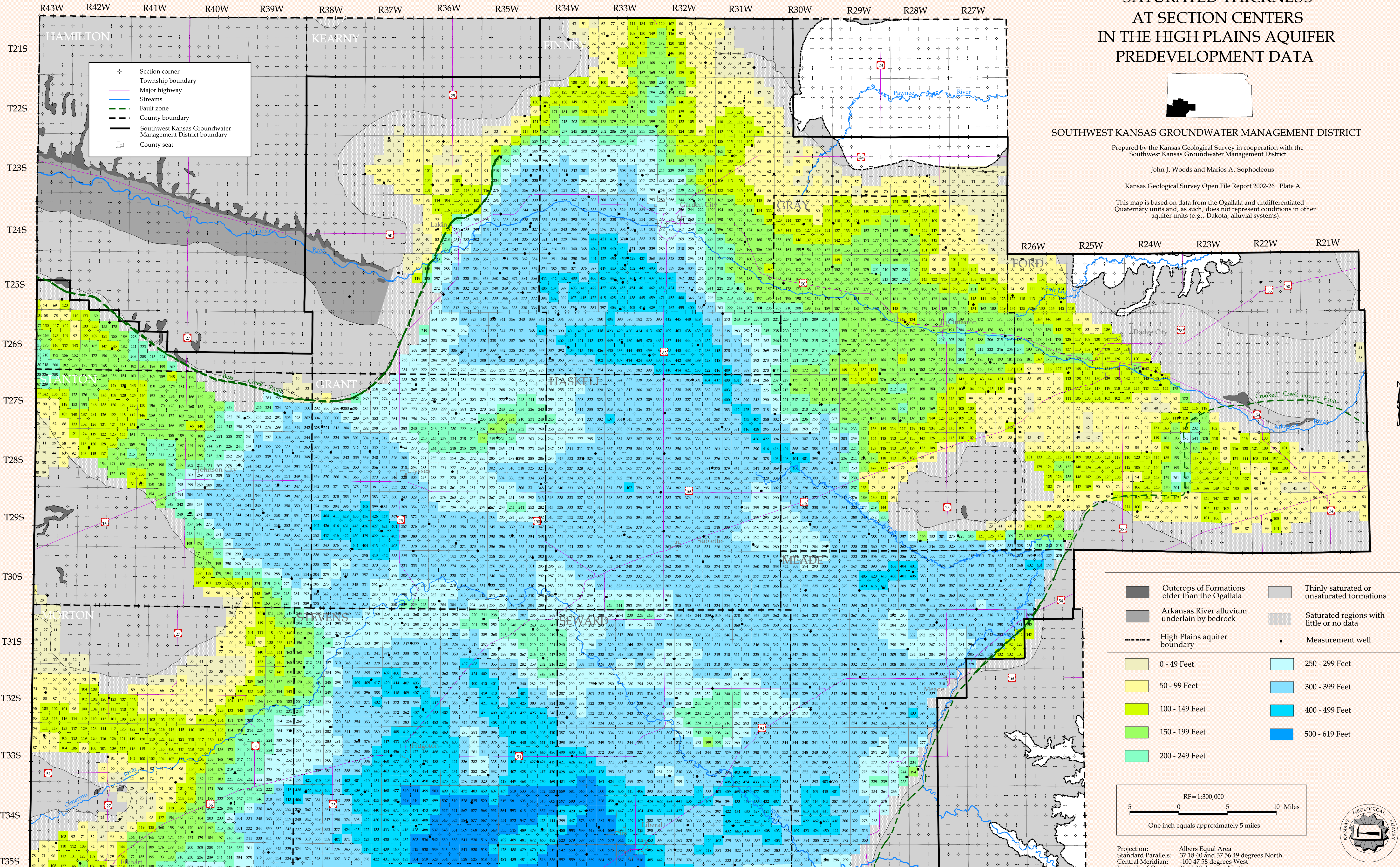
