0-60 feet

alluvial terrace deposits

coarse gravel to clay; late Pleistocene to Holocene ages
0-130 feet

Qp

upland intermittent lake (playa) deposits

silt to clay; late Pleistocene to Holocene ages; 0-6 ft

Qm

Meade Formation

granitic coarse gravel and sand, highly oxidized, of the lower Grand Island member grading upward into sand and silt of the Sappa member that includes lentils of Pearlette ash; early to middle Pleistocene ages
0-140 feet

Qb

Blanco Formation

coarse gravel to sand of Cretaceous and Permian material overlain by alluvial silt; early Pleistocene age
0-140 feet

sand occurring in dunes; late Pleistocene to Holocene ages
