To participate in this workshop, you must have an installed and running copy of our SurfSeis 6 software on your computer.

The online workshop consists of **five four-hour days** (~20 class hours). The sessions will run **9:00a-12:45p CDT** (Central Daylight Time, GMT -5) each day and include a 20-minute break. Before registration, please confirm the workshop is convenient in your time zone. This workshop schedule is convenient to the **Americas, Europe, Africa, and the Middle East** attendees. Registration is open to all, but the timing is most favorable for these regions. *Additional workshops will be announced for those in India, China, Australia and the West Pacific area.*

The workshop is free. An optional workshop notebook is available on request.

Workshop notebooks are optional but having one can improve your experience of the workshop, overall knowledge retention, and as future reference.

Workshop materials, such as the video presentations and notebook files are copyrighted by the Kansas Geological Survey, (KGS) and cannot be recorded, copied, or redistributed by anyone other than KGS.

We expect that each participant will have their own KGS dongle (that comes with SurfSeis6, SurfSeis6 demo, and WinSeis). The class includes hands-on participation with the exercises, and you may not benefit fully if you are sharing a dongle.

For enhanced experience of the workshop, we recommend registrants review the SurfSeis6 Tutorial.pdf before the workshop using their SurfSeis6 software. The .pdf file can be found in the Manuals subfolder of your SurfSeis 6 installation folder (e.g., [C:\SurfSeis6\Manuals](#)).

The deadline for registration is September 11, if a workbook and/or demo license is requested to allow adequate mailing time. Otherwise, the deadline is September 18, 2026.
